

# Changes to train times

## This week

### Monday 10 to Friday 14 June

As a result of engineering work, the following late night trains between Grove Park/Sundridge Park/Bromley North will not run:

**Grove Park to Bromley North:**

- 2355 (Mon to Thurs), 0015, 0035, 0055 (Tues to Fri)

**Bromley North to Grove Park:**

- 0004, 0024 & 0044 (Tues to Fri)

Valid train tickets will be accepted for travel on following local bus routes, in any direction between Grove Park, Sundridge Park and Bromley North.

Grove Park - Bromley North - local bus routes 126 or 261.  
Grove Park - Sundridge Park - bus 126/261 to Plectow Green and change for 314.  
Sundridge Park - Bromley North - local bus 314.

**Late night engineering work between Deptford/Blackheath and Dartford via Charlton and Woolwich Arsenal will affect the following train services:**

- 2342 (Mon to Thurs only) Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal.** This service is diverted on departure from Blackheath at 0002 and calls at Kidbrooke 0005, Eltham 0009, Falconwood 0013, Welling 0016, Bexleyheath 0019, Barnehurst 0022 and terminates at Dartford 0035. A connecting replacement bus will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, departing Lewisham at 0009 calling at Blackheath 0017, Charlton 0029, Woolwich Dockyard 0034, Woolwich Arsenal 0040, Plumstead 0044, Abbey Wood 0050, Belvedere 0054, Erith 0059, Slade Green 0107 and terminates at Dartford at 0118.

- 0002 & 0032 (Tues & Wed only) Cannon Street to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal services will not run;** however, additional train services to Dartford will depart Cannon Street at 0002 & 0032 respectively,

calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barnehurst. Replacement bus services from Cannon Street to Dartford, via Greenwich and Woolwich Arsenal, will depart Cannon Street at 0002 & 0032, calling at London Bridge 0010 & 0040, Deptford 0024 & 0054, Greenwich 0029 & 0059, Maze Hill 0036 & 0106, Westcombe Park 0041 & 0111, Charlton 00548 & 01s18, Woolwich Dockyard 00s53 & 01s23, Woolwich Arsenal 00s59 & 01s29, Plumstead 01s03 & 01s33, Abbey Wood 01s09 & 01s39, Belvedere 01s13 & 01s43, Erith 01s18 & 01s48, Slade Green 01s26 & 01s56 and terminates Dartford at 01s37 & 0207.

**Note:** s = sets down passengers only.

- 0012 & 0042 (Thurs & Fri only) Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal.** Both these services are diverted on departure from Blackheath at 0037 & 0103 respectively and calls at Kidbrooke 0040 & 0106, Eltham 0044 & 0110, Falconwood 0047 & 0113, Welling 0050 & 0116, Bexleyheath 0054 & 0120, Barnehurst 0057 & 0123 and terminates at Dartford 0109 & 0136. Connecting replacement buses will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, departing Lewisham at 0044 & 0110 respectively calling at Blackheath 0052 & 0118, Charlton 0104 & 0130, Woolwich Dockyard 0109 & 0135, Woolwich Arsenal 0115 & 0141, Plumstead 0119 & 0145, Abbey Wood 0125 & 0151, Belvedere 0129 & 0155, Erith 0134 & 0200 Slade Green 0142 & 0208 and terminates at Dartford at 0153 & 0219.

- 0102 (Tues & Wed only) Cannon Street to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal services will not run;** however, an additional train service to Dartford will depart Cannon Street at 0102, calling at London Bridge 0106,

Lewisham 0114, Blackheath 0117, Kidbrooke 0120, Eltham 0123, Falconwood 0126, Welling 0129, Bexleyheath 0132, Barnehurst 0135 and terminates at Dartford at 0145. A connecting replacement bus to Dartford will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, departing Lewisham at 0124 calling at Blackheath 0132, Charlton 0144, Woolwich Dockyard 0149, Woolwich Arsenal 0155, Plumstead 0159, Abbey Wood 0205, Belvedere 0209, Erith 0214, Slade Green 0222 and terminates at Dartford at 0233.

**Late night engineering work between Hither Green and Grove Park will affect train services on Monday to Thursday nights. As a result, the following services are revised:**

**Cannon Street to Orpington services**

The following late night departures from Cannon Street will not call at Lewisham:

- 2345 (Wed & Thurs only):** passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Cannon Street travel to London Bridge and change for 2359 London Bridge to Dartford train service. A connecting replacement bus service operates between New Cross and Hither Green, departing New Cross at 2354, St Johns 2359, Lewisham 0006 and arrives Hither Green at 0015. Connecting train service for stations to Orpington departs Hither Green at 0023.
- 2350 (Mon & Tues only):** passengers for Lewisham, travel by the amended 0002 Cannon Street to Dartford service. A connecting replacement bus service operates between New Cross and Hither Green, departing New Cross at 0010, St Johns 0015, Lewisham 0022 and arrives Hither Green at 0031. Connecting train service for stations to Orpington departs Hither Green at 0043.

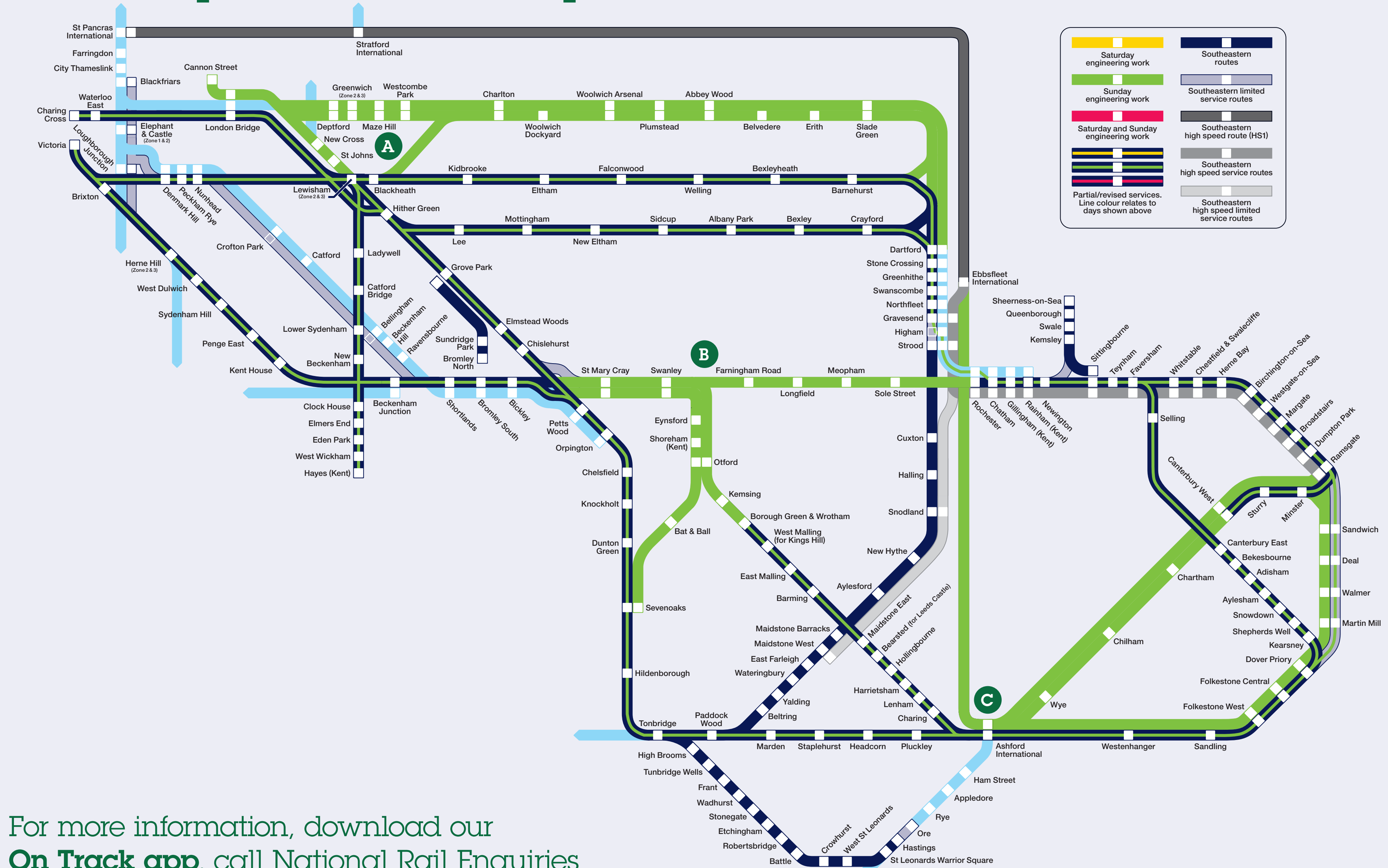
- 0020 (Tues & Wed only),** passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Cannon Street and London Bridge are advised to travel by 0027 Cannon Street to Hayes train. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington to travel on 0111 replacement bus service to Hither Green and change for connecting train.
- 0020 Cannon Street to Lewisham (Thurs & Fri only),** this scheduled bus service will run as scheduled to Lewisham and is further extended to terminate at Hither Green at 0103.
- 0110 (Tues & Wed only):** passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Cannon Street, London Bridge, New Cross, St Johns to travel by replacement bus service departing Cannon Street at 0110, London Bridge at 0118, New Cross 0132, St Johns 0137. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington to travel on this replacement bus service departing Lewisham at 0144.

**Charing Cross to Orpington**

The following late night departures from Charing Cross will not call at Lewisham:

- 0018 (Thurs & Fri only)** passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Charing Cross and Waterloo East are advised to travel by 0026 Charing Cross to Dartford train. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington to travel on 0037 replacement bus service.
- 0050 (Thurs & Fri only)** passengers for Lewisham to travel by 0050 (Thurs & Fri only) Charing Cross to Orpington additional bus service will operate, calling at Waterloo East (0058) and London Bridge (0105). Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington to travel on 0125 replacement bus service, setting down at all stations to Orpington.

There is no scheduled engineering work on this date, a scheduled Saturday Southeastern timetable will operate

### Sunday 16 June

**A** Engineering work is taking place between Cannon Street, Greenwich, and Lewisham; Greenwich/Blackheath to Dartford via Charlton and Woolwich Arsenal on Sunday 16 June. As a result:

- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains will not run.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup and Greenwich trains will not run.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains will run as scheduled to Blackheath and are then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford, calling at St Johns, New Cross, Deptford, Greenwich and Westcombe Park, Charlton and all stations via Woolwich Arsenal to Dartford.
- Cannon Street to Hayes trains will not run; however, additional trains will operate a half hourly timetable service between Charing Cross, Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham, Ladywell and all stations to Hayes.
- Victoria to Dartford via Denmark Hill, Lewisham and Bexleyheath trains will run as scheduled.
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are revised to call additionally at Lewisham.
- Charing Cross to Sevenoaks via Lewisham and Grove Park trains will run as scheduled.

**Note:** GTR trains between Kentish Town and Rainham are revised to run an hourly train service between Dartford and Rainham.

### Valid Train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Cannon Street, Charing Cross, Embankment (for Charing Cross), London Bridge, Southwark (for Waterloo East), Victoria and Waterloo underground stations.
- on London Overground between New Cross and Canada Water.
- on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) between Greenwich and Lewisham.

**B** Engineering work is taking place between St Mary Cray and Rochester; Swanley and Borough Green & Wrotham/Sevenoaks on Sunday 16 June. There are no trains calling at St Mary Cray, Swanley, Farningham Road, Longfield, Meopham, Sole Street, Eynsford, Shoreham, Otford or Bat & Ball.

- Victoria to Ramsgate & Dover Priory via Faversham trains are revised to depart from Victoria seven (7) minutes earlier than scheduled and are diverted via an alternative route running non-stop from Victoria to Strood and then calling at all stations to Faversham. These trains divide at Faversham with the front portion of the train, calling at all stations to Ramsgate and the rear portion calling at all stations to Dover Priory via Canterbury East.
- Victoria to Canterbury East via Denmark Hill trains will not run.
- Victoria to Canterbury West via Maidstone East trains will not run.
- An additional half hourly train service will operate between Victoria and Bromley South, calling at Denmark Hill.

### Replacement buses will operate on following routes:

- an hourly bus service between Bromley South and Strood, calling at St Mary Cray, Swanley, Farningham Road, Longfield and Meopham; a connecting minibuses runs between Meopham and Sole Street. Change at Strood for connecting train services to Medway towns and stations to Ramsgate/Dover Priory.
- an hourly bus service between Bromley South and Borough Green & Wrotham, calling at St Mary Cray, Swanley and Otford; a connecting shuttle train service operates between Borough Green & Wrotham and Ashford International, calling all stations via Maidstone East.
- Victoria to Dartford via Bexleyheath trains will run as scheduled.
- Victoria to Orpington via Heme Hill trains will run as scheduled.

**Note:** Blackfriars to Sevenoaks via Catford (GTR) trains will run as scheduled to Bromley South and diverted, after Bickley, to call at Pette Wood, Orpington then non-stop to Sevenoaks.

Replacement GTR buses will operate between Bromley South and Sevenoaks, calling at all stations via Swanley and Bat & Ball.

**C** Engineering work is taking place between Ebbsfleet International to Ashford International; Platforms 3-6 at Ashford International; Ashford International to Canterbury West on Sunday 16 June. As a result:

- St Pancras International to Margate via Canterbury West trains will not run.
- St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Dover Priory trains will terminate at Ebbsfleet International, with replacement coaches operating an hourly service between Ebbsfleet International and Ashford International.

- St Pancras International to Dover Priory via Strood and Faversham trains will terminate at Ramsgate.
- St Pancras International to Faversham via Strood trains will operate as scheduled.
- An additional hourly train service will operate between Victoria, Bromley South, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and Ashford International only; connecting with replacement buses which operate between Ashford International and Canterbury West.
- Additional trains will operate an hourly timetable service between Canterbury West and Margate, calling at Sturry, Minster, Ramsgate and Broadstairs.
- Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Canterbury West trains will run as scheduled to Ashford International and are then diverted on departure to call at Folkestone West, Folkestone Central, Dover Priory and all stations to Ramsgate. A connecting replacement bus from Ashford will operate calling at all stations to Canterbury West.
- Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Ashford International trains will run as scheduled.
- Victoria to Canterbury West via Maidstone East trains will not run; because of engineering work elsewhere; a shuttle train service will operate between Borough Green & Wrotham and Ashford International, with a connecting replacement bus service calling all stations to Canterbury West.

### Bikes on rail replacement bus services

You won't be able to carry a bike onto a replacement bus service but might be able to fit a folding bike in the luggage area if there's enough space.
