

# Changes to train times

## This week

### Monday 13 to Friday 17 May

Late night engineering work between Tonbridge and Hastings on Monday and Tuesday nights, certain trains (see list below) in both directions will be replaced by buses between Tonbridge, Tunbridge Wells, Wadhurst and Hastings stations:

- 2200, 2230, 2300, 2330 (Mon) Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells.
- 0025 (Tue) Cannon Street to Tunbridge Wells.
- 2245 & 2345 (Mon & Tue) Charing Cross Street to Hastings.
- 2250 (Mon) Hastings to Tonbridge.
- 0005 & 0035 (Tue) Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge.
- 2305 (Mon) Tunbridge Wells to Cannon Street; starts Tonbridge at 2315; additional buses at 2245/ 2305/ 2335 Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge.
- Also, late night connecting minibus services operate between Battle and Crowhurst.

As a result of engineering work, the following late night trains between Grove Park/Sundridge Park/Bromley North will not run:

**Grove Park to Bromley North:**

- 2355 (Mon to Wed), 0015, 0035, 0055 (Tue to Thu)

**Bromley North to Grove Park:**

- 0004, 0024 & 0044 (Tue to Thu)

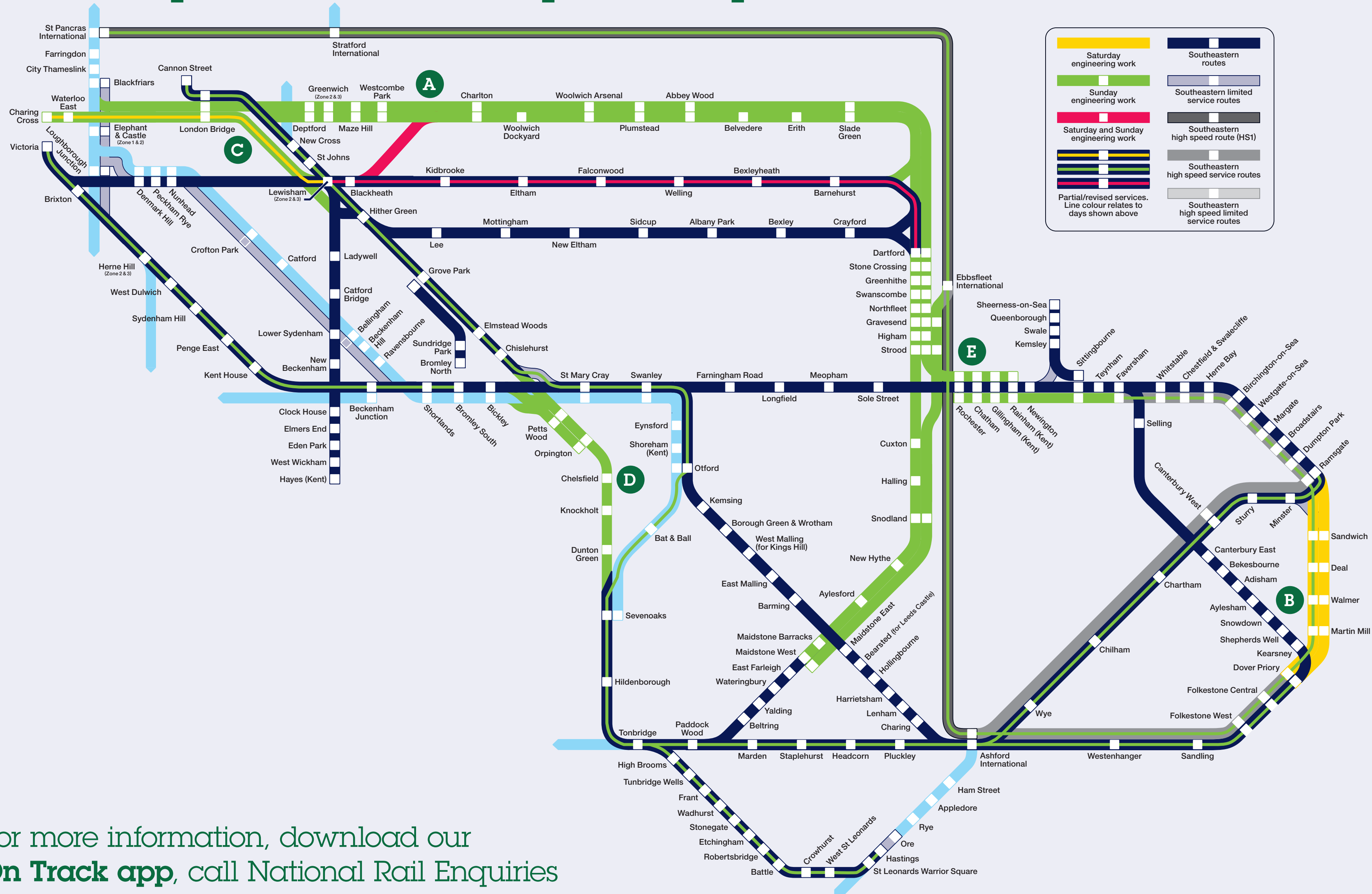
Valid train tickets will be accepted for travel on following local bus routes, in any direction between Grove Park, Sundridge Park and Bromley North.

- Grove Park - Bromley North - local bus routes 126 or 261.
- Grove Park - Sundridge Park - bus 126/261 to Platow Green and change for 314.
- Sundridge Park - Bromley North - local bus 314.

Engineering work between Lewisham, Hither Green and Dartford via Sidcup; will affect the following late night train services:

- 2350 (Mon & Tue only) Charing Cross to Gravesend service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and runs non-stop to Dartford and then calls at all stations to Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0017 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- 2350 (Wed & Thu only) Charing Cross to Dartford service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and runs non-stop to Dartford and then calls at all stations to Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Dartford will depart Lewisham at 0017 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford.
- 2356 (Mon to Thu) Hither Green to Dartford - to maintain frequency of service - this additional bus service will operate calling at Lee 0003, Mottingham 0012, New Eltham 0017, Sidcup 0026, Albany Park Hurst Road 0032, Bexley 0035, Crayford 0045 and terminates at Dartford at 0053.
- 0002 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Gravesend services on departure from Lewisham is diverted and runs non-stop to Dartford and then set down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0029 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- 0032 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Gravesend services on departure from Lewisham is diverted and runs non-stop to Dartford and then set down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0059 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- 0052 (Tue & Wed only) Cannon Street to Gravesend service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and runs non-stop to Dartford and then sets down only at Greenhithe and terminates at Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0114 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at Greenhithe and terminates at Gravesend.

**A** Engineering work is taking place between Blackheath and Charlton on Saturday 18 May. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains will run as scheduled to Blackheath and are then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.

Engineering work is taking place between Deptford/Blackheath to Dartford via Charlton and Woolwich Arsenal on Sunday 19 May. As a result:

- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains will not run.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup and Greenwich trains will not run.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains will start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge run as scheduled to Blackheath and are then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford, calling at St Johns, New Cross, Deptford, Greenwich and all stations via Charlton and Woolwich Arsenal to Dartford.
- Victoria to Dartford via Denmark Hill, Lewisham and Bexleyheath trains will run as scheduled.

Note: Kentish Town and Rainham (GTR) trains between will not run.

Valid Train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Cannon Street, Charing Cross, Embankment (for Charing Cross), London Bridge, Southwark (for Waterloo East) and Waterloo underground stations.
- on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) between Greenwich and Lewisham.

**B** Engineering work is taking place between Dover Priory and Ramsgate on Saturday 18 May. As a result:

- St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Ashford International and Dover Priory trains are retimed and revised to terminate at Dover Priory, with connecting replacement buses calling at all stations between Dover Priory and Ramsgate.

- St Pancras International to Dover Priory via Faversham trains are revised to terminate at Ramsgate, with connecting replacement buses calling at all stations to Dover Priory.

**C** Engineering work is taking place between Charing Cross and Lewisham; on Sunday 19 May. Charing Cross and Waterloo East stations are closed. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Hastings trains are revised and retimed to start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge, Chislehurst and then diverted via an alternative route calling at Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and then as scheduled stopping pattern to Hastings.
- Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Canterbury West trains are revised and retimed to start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge, and then diverted via an alternative route calling at Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and then as scheduled stopping pattern to Ramsgate.
- Charing Cross to Dover Priory trains are revised and retimed to start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge, and then diverted via an alternative route calling at Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and then as scheduled stopping pattern to Dover Priory.
- Charing Cross to Sevenoaks trains are revised and retimed to start from Cannon Street calling at London Bridge, New Cross and St Johns, Lewisham, Hither Green, Grove Park, Elmstead and terminates at Chislehurst. Connecting replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Chislehurst and Sevenoaks, calling at Petts Wood, Orpington, Chelsfield, Knockholt and Dunton Green.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains are revised and retimed to start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge run as scheduled to Blackheath and are then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.

- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are revised to start from Cannon Street, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham and then as scheduled via Sidcup and further revised to terminate at Dartford. Connecting replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Dartford and Gravesend, calling at Stone Crossing, Greenhithe, Swanscombe and Northfleet.
- Cannon Street to Hayes trains run as scheduled.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Cannon Street, Charing Cross, Embankment (for Charing Cross), London Bridge, Southwark (for Waterloo East) and Waterloo underground stations.

**D** Engineering work is taking place between Bickley/Chislehurst/Orpington and Sevenoaks on Sunday 19 May. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Hastings services are retimed and revised to start from Cannon Street and call at London Bridge, Chislehurst, Sevenoaks and as scheduled to Hastings. Connecting replacement buses will operate a half hourly service between Chislehurst and Orpington only.
- Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Canterbury West services are retimed and revised to start from Cannon Street and call at London Bridge, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge, and then as scheduled to Ramsgate.
- Charing Cross to Dover Priory services are retimed and revised to start from Cannon Street and call at London Bridge, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge, and then as scheduled to Dover Priory.
- Charing Cross to Sevenoaks via Grove Park services are revised to terminate at Chislehurst; with connecting replacement buses operating a half hourly bus service between Chislehurst and Sevenoaks, calling at Petts Wood, Orpington, Chelsfield, Knockholt and Dunton Green.
- Victoria to Orpington via Heme Hill services are revised to terminate at Bromley South; with connecting replacement buses operating a half hourly bus service between Bromley South and Orpington, calling at Bickley and Petts Wood.

Note: Blackfriars to Sevenoaks via Catford (GTR) services will run as scheduled.

**E** Engineering work is taking place between Dartford and Rochester; Strood and Maidstone West on Sunday 19 May. As a result:

- St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Faversham trains will terminate at Ebbsfleet International. A replacement bus service will operate between Ebbsfleet and Meopham, connecting into the Victoria to Ramsgate & Dover Priory services calling additionally at Meopham.
- A second replacement bus service will operate between Ebbsfleet International, Gravesend and Strood.
- St Pancras International to Faversham trains will not run.
- St Pancras International to Dover Priory via Ashford International trains are revised and extended to terminate at Faversham.

Note: Kentish Town to Rainham (GTR) services will not run.

- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains are revised to start from Cannon Street calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, Blackheath and are then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly service between Dartford and Gillingham, calling at all stations except Higham; (see below for replacement bus services to Higham)
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are revised to terminate at Dartford; replacement buses will operate a half hourly service, calling at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- Strood to Tonbridge trains are revised to start from Maidstone West and run as scheduled to Tonbridge; however, replacement buses will operate an hourly timetable from Gravesend, calling at Higham, Strood and all stations to Maidstone West.
