

Changes to train times

This week

Monday 15 to Thursday 18 April

Engineering work between Brixton and Herne Hill will affect train services on Monday to Thursday nights, as a result:

- 2342 (Monday to Thursday only) Bromley South to Victoria additional bus service will operate, calling at Shortlands, Beckenham Junction, Kent House, Penge East, Sydenham Hill, West Dulwich-Croxted Road and Herne Hill.
- 2354 (Monday to Thursday) Orpington to Victoria train is diverted on departure from Shortlands and then calls additionally at Denmark Hill and terminates at Victoria at 0034. Passengers travelling to/from Beckenham Junction, Kent House, Penge East, Sydenham Hill, West Dulwich*, Herne Hill, are advised to travel by replacement bus service operating between Bromley South and Victoria, departing Bromley South at 0012.
- 0024 (Tuesday to Friday) Herne Hill to Orpington additional bus service will operate to maintain service frequency, calling at West Dulwich-Croxted Road, Sydenham Hill and all stations to Orpington.
- 0028 (Tuesday to Friday) Victoria to Orpington train is diverted on departure from Victoria and runs non-stop to Shortlands and then as the scheduled stopping pattern to Orpington.

Passengers travelling to/from Herne Hill, West Dulwich*, Sydenham Hill, Penge East, Kent House, Beckenham Junction are advised to travel by replacement bus service operating between Victoria and Orpington, departing Victoria at 0029.

Note: * = replacement buses call at West Dulwich Croxted Road
Late night engineering work between Hither Green and Grove Park will affect train services on Monday to Thursday nights. As a result, the following services are revised:

Cannon Street to Orpington services
The following late night departures from Cannon Street will not call at Lewisham:

- 2345 (Wednesday & Thursday only); passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Cannon Street travel to London Bridge and change for 2359 London Bridge to Gravesend train.
- 2350 (Monday & Tuesday only); passengers for Lewisham, travel to New Cross and change for 00:10 replacement bus to Lewisham.
- 0020 (Tuesday & Wednesday only); passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Cannon Street and London Bridge are advised to travel by 0027 Cannon Street to Hayes train. Passengers from

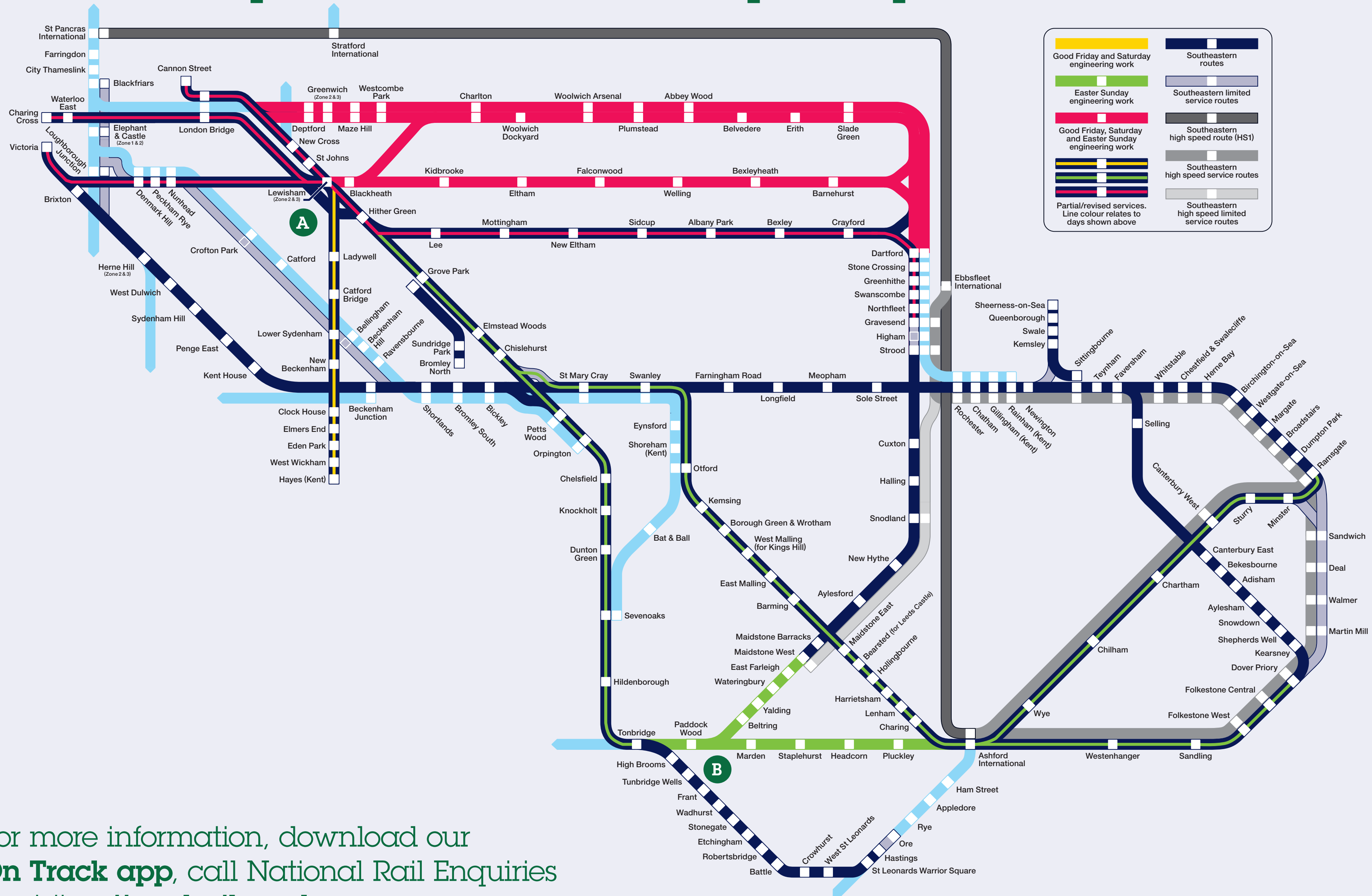
Lewisham for to stations to Orpington to travel on 0035 replacement bus service.

- 0110 (Thursday & Friday only); passengers from Cannon Street and London Bridge to travel by replacement bus service departing Cannon Street at 0110 and London Bridge at 0118. Passengers from Lewisham for to stations to Orpington to travel on 0123 replacement bus service.

Charing Cross to Orpington
The following late night departures from Charing Cross will not call at Lewisham:

- 0018 (Thursday & Friday only) passengers for Lewisham, travelling from Charing Cross and Waterloo East are advised to travel by 0026 Charing Cross to Dartford train. Passengers from Lewisham for to stations to Orpington to travel on 0037 replacement bus service.
- 0050 (Thursday & Friday only). Note: Passengers for Lewisham to travel by 0050 (Thursday & Friday only) Charing Cross to Orpington additional bus service will operate, calling at Waterloo East (0058) and London Bridge (0105). Passengers from Lewisham for to stations to Orpington to travel on 0108 replacement bus service.

A A scheduled Saturday timetable will operate on Good Friday 19 April with the following engineering works.

A Engineering work is taking place between Deptford to Dartford via Charlton; Lewisham to Dartford via Blackheath and Bexleyheath on Good Friday 19 April and on Saturday 20 April. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains **will not run**.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Sidcup trains **will not run**.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Bexleyheath trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup and Greenwich trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Barmehurst via Greenwich trains **will not run**.
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are retimed and are revised to call additionally at Lewisham and then as scheduled from New Eltham.
- Charing Cross to Hayes trains will call additionally at Lewisham and then all stations to Hayes.
- Cannon Street to Slade Green via Bexleyheath trains will run as scheduled to Lewisham and then are diverted to call at Lee, Mottingham, New Eltham, Sidcup, Albany Park, Bexley, Crayford and revised to terminate at Dartford.
- Victoria to Gravesend trains will run as scheduled to Lewisham and are then diverted to call at Hither Green, New Eltham, Sidcup, Bexley, Crayford, Dartford and then as scheduled to Gravesend.

- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford via Bexleyheath calling at Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barmehurst.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford via Greenwich and Woolwich Arsenal, calling at St Johns, New Cross, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton, Woolwich Dockyard, Woolwich Arsenal, Plumstead, Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith and Slade Green.

Note: Luton to Rainham (GTR Thameslink) services are revised and will only operate a half hourly service between Dartford and Rainham.

Engineering work is taking place between Deptford to Dartford via Charlton; Lewisham to Dartford via Blackheath and Bexleyheath on Easter Sunday 21 April. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup and Greenwich trains will operate as scheduled to Crayford and then diverted to terminate at Dartford.
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are retimed and are revised to call additionally at Lewisham and then as scheduled from Hither Green.
- Cannon Street to Hayes trains will run as scheduled.
- Victoria to Dartford via Denmark Hill and Lewisham trains will run as scheduled to Lewisham and are then diverted to call at Hither Green, New Eltham, Sidcup, Bexley, Crayford and then terminates at Dartford.

- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford via Bexleyheath calling and at Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barmehurst.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Dartford via Greenwich and Woolwich Arsenal, calling at St Johns, New Cross, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton, Woolwich Dockyard, Woolwich Arsenal, Plumstead, Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith and Slade Green.

Note: Kentish Town to Rainham (GTR Thameslink) services are revised and will only operate a half hourly service between Dartford and Rainham.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

On the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) services between Greenwich and Lewisham. In addition to the rail replacement buses in operation between Lewisham and Dartford: Passengers with valid rail tickets are allowed to travel on any reasonable TfL bus route between the following points: Lewisham, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton, Woolwich Dockyard, Woolwich Arsenal, Plumstead, Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith, Slade Green, Dartford, Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath, Barmehurst, New Eltham, Sidcup, Crayford, North Greenhithe.

B Engineering work is taking place between Tonbridge and Ashford International, and Paddock Wood and Maidstone West on Easter Sunday 21 April. As a result:

- Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Tonbridge trains are revised to terminate at Tonbridge, with replacement buses operating an hourly timetable between Tonbridge and Ashford International, calling at Paddock Wood, Marden, Staplehurst, Headcorn and Pluckley.
- Charing Cross/Ramsgate via Canterbury West trains on departure from London Bridge will be diverted, calling additionally at Otford and Maidstone East, these services will divide at Ashford International with portions going forward to: Ramsgate, calling at Wye, Canterbury West, Sturry and Minster; Dover Priory, calling at Westernhanger, Sandling, Folkestone West and Folkestone Central.
- Tonbridge and Strood via Maidstone West trains are revised to start from Maidstone West calling at all stations to Strood; with replacement minibus service operating an hourly timetable, operating between Tonbridge and Maidstone West calling at Paddock Wood, Beltring, Yalding, Wateringbury and East Farleigh.

Also, engineering work is taking place between Herne Hill and Blackfriars on Easter Sunday 21 April.

- Blackfriars to Sevenoaks (Thameslink) services are revised to start from Victoria and will run non-stop to Denmark Hill and then as scheduled.

A scheduled Saturday timetable will operate on Monday 22 April.
