

Changes to train times

This week

Monday 19 to Friday 23 August

Engineering work between Lewisham, Hither Green and Dartford via Sidcup; will affect the following late night train services:

- **2320 (Wed & Thu only) Charing Cross to Dartford** service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and revised to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford. A connecting replacement bus to Dartford will depart Lewisham at 2347 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford.
- **2332 (Wed & Thu only) Charing Cross to Gravesend** service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and revised to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Dartford will depart Lewisham at 2359 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- **2332 (Wed & Thu only) Crayford to London Bridge** service terminates at Sidcup, with a connecting replacement bus service departing at Sidcup at 2348 for all stations to Lewisham and terminates at London Bridge at 0047.
- **2335 (Mon & Tues only) Gravesend to London Bridge & 2335 (Wed & Thu only) Gravesend to Charing Cross** services are diverted on departure from Dartford and revised to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Lewisham and then as scheduled. A connecting replacement bus service for Sidcup Line stations to London Bridge departs Dartford at 2358 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Lewisham.
- **2345 (Wed & Thu only) Cannon Street to Orpington** service will not call at Lewisham. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington, are advised to travel by 0019 additional bus from Lewisham and change at Hither Green.
- **2350 (Wed & Thu only) Charing Cross to Gravesend** service will not run.

- **0019 (Thu & Fri only) Lewisham to Dartford** – to maintain frequency of service, this additional bus service will operate calling at Hither Green 0028, Lee 0035, Mottingham 0044, New Eltham 0049, Sidcup 0058, Albany Park Hurst Road 0104, Bexley 0107, Crayford 0117 and terminates at Dartford 0125
- **0002 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Gravesend** service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and revised to call at all stations to Greenhithe and then to set down only at all stations between Greenhithe and Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0029 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- **0018 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Orpington** service will not call at Lewisham. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington, are advised to travel by 0019 additional bus from Lewisham and change at Hither Green.
- **0020 (Tue & Wed only) Cannon Street to Orpington** will not call at Lewisham. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington, are advised to travel by 0019 additional bus from Lewisham and change at Hither Green.
- **0032 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Gravesend** service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and revised to call at all stations to Dartford, then calls Greenhithe and terminates at Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0059 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at all stations between Dartford and Gravesend.
- **0050 (Thu & Fri only) Charing Cross to Orpington** service, is retimed to depart from Charing Cross at 0100 and further revised to not call at Lewisham. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington, are advised to travel by 0108 additional bus from Lewisham and change at Hither Green.

- **0052 (Tue & Wed only) Cannon Street to Gravesend** service on departure from Lewisham is diverted and revised to call at all stations to Dartford, then calls Greenhithe and terminates at Gravesend. A connecting replacement bus to Gravesend will depart Lewisham at 0114 calling at all stations via Sidcup to Dartford and then sets down only at Greenhithe and terminates at Gravesend.
- **0110 (Tue & Wed only) Cannon Street to Orpington** service, is retimed to depart from Cannon Street at 0120 and further revised to not call at Lewisham. Passengers from Lewisham for stations to Orpington, are advised to travel by 0123 additional bus from Lewisham and change at Hither Green.

Late night engineering work between Maidstone East and Ashford International will affect the following train services on Monday to Thursday nights:

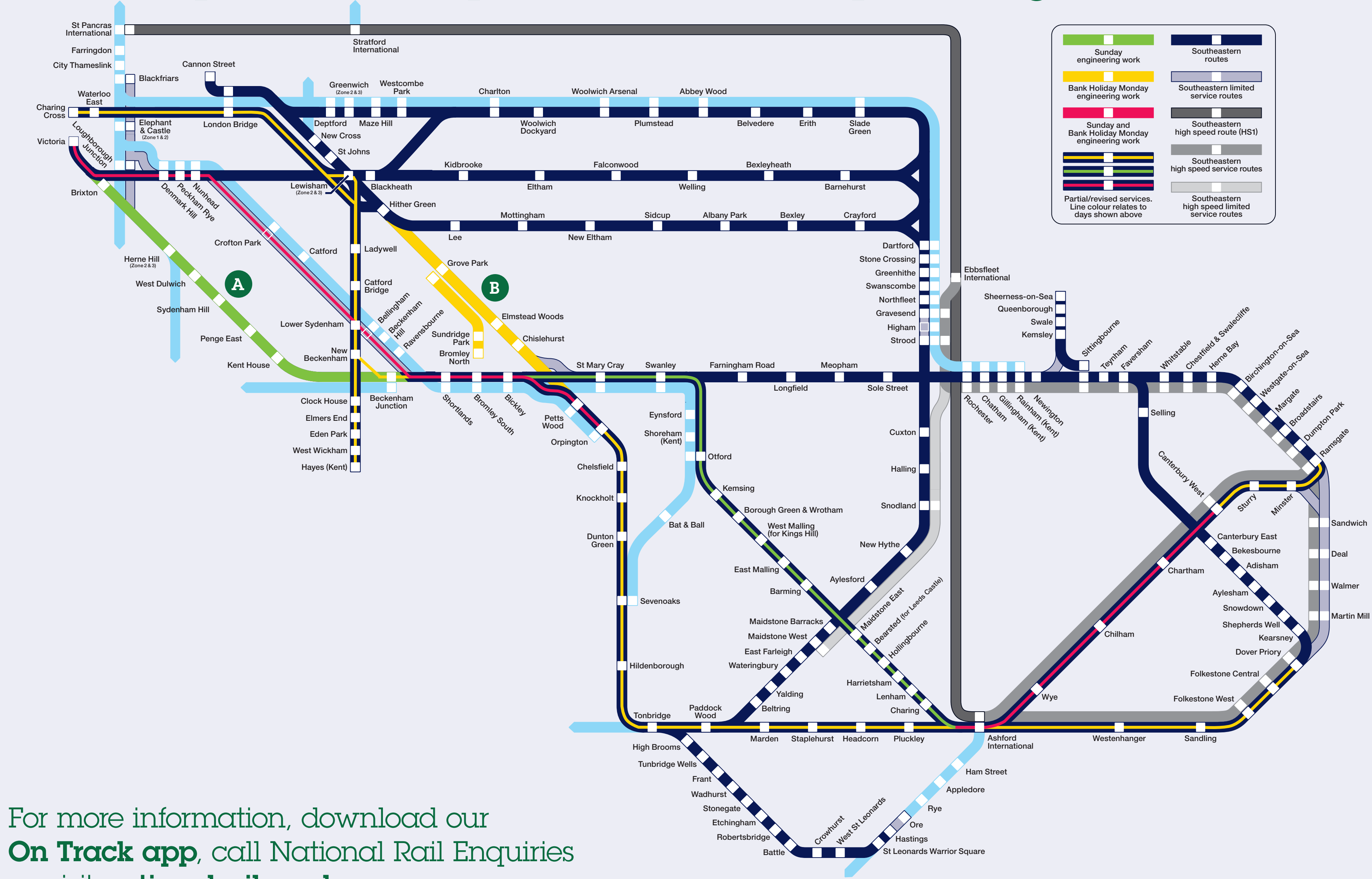
- **2355 (Mon to Thu) & 0025 (Tue to Fri) Victoria to Ashford International** trains – will terminate at Maidstone East, with replacement buses calling all stations to Ashford International.
- **2315 (Mon, Wed and Thu only) Ramsgate to Gillingham** train will terminate at Sittingbourne with connecting replacement bus to Gillingham.
- **2342 (Mon to Thu) Victoria to Gillingham** train will terminate at Sole Street; change at Meopham for connecting replacement buses to Rochester, Chatham and Gillingham.
- **2355 (Mon to Thu) St Pancras to Faversham** train will terminate at Ebbsfleet International, with connecting replacement bus service at 0020 to Faversham.

- **0010 (Tue to Fri) Victoria to Ramsgate** is revised and will run non-stop to terminate at Stood; with connecting replacement bus departing Stood at 0115 calling at all stations bus to Sittingbourne. This bus connects with a train service departing Sittingbourne at 0218 calling all stations to Ramsgate.
- **0040 (Tue to Fri) Victoria to Gillingham** train will terminate at Meopham with connecting bus to Gillingham.
- **0115 (Tue to Fri) Sittingbourne to Ramsgate** additional train service will run calling at all stations.

Also, there are no timetabled buses operating in either direction between Faversham and Ramsgate on Tuesday night, the following trains are revised to operate in the scheduled Wednesday to Friday timings:

- **2240 & 2310 (Tue) Victoria to Ramsgate.**
 - **2225 (Tue) St Pancras to Ramsgate via Faversham.**
- Also on Tuesday night,
- **2210 (Tue) Victoria to Dover Priory** train is retimed to depart Faversham at 2334 and Canterbury East at 2348 and setting down only at intermediate stations to Dover Priory, arriving at 0016.
 - **2212 & 2312 (Tue) St Pancras to Ramsgate via Ashford International** trains are revised to terminate at Margate, calling additionally at Broadstairs.
 - **2248 (Tue) Ramsgate to Faversham** train is revised to depart at 2315 and calls additionally at Teynham and terminates at Sittingbourne with connecting replacement bus to Gillingham. (Note: 2315 Ramsgate to Gillingham bus service will not run.)
 - **2310 (Tue) Dover to Gillingham** train will terminate at Faversham, change for connecting services.

There is no planned engineering work on this date, a scheduled Saturday Southeastern timetable will operate

Sunday 25 August

A Engineering work is taking place between Brixton and Shortlands via Heme Hill on Sunday 25 August. As a result:

- Victoria to Orpington via Heme Hill trains, on departure from Victoria, are revised and diverted calling additionally at Denmark Hill, Peckham Rye and Nunhead and then run non-stop to Shortlands and as scheduled between Bromley South and Orpington.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly service between Denmark Hill and Bromley South, calling at Heme Hill, West Dulwich (Croxted Road), Sydenham Hill, Penge East, Kent House, Beckenham Junction and Shortlands.
- Victoria to Canterbury West via Maidstone East services will run via an alternative route between Victoria and Bromley South and will run 9 minutes later than scheduled between Bromley South and Ashford International.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- Passengers travelling to/from Brixton, holding valid train tickets to use the London Underground Victoria line services between Victoria and Brixton.

B Bank Holiday Monday 26 August (Note: a Saturday timetable will operate on Bank Holiday Monday 26 August, with the following changes):

- Engineering work is taking place between Hither Green and Pette Wood; Grove Park and Bromley North. There are no trains calling at Grove Park, Sundridge Park, Bromley North, Elmstead Woods and Chislehurst stations on Bank Holiday Monday 26 August. As a result:
 - Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Tonbridge and Canterbury West trains are retimed and revised to run to and from London Victoria, calling additionally at Bromley South and Orpington, and then as scheduled calling pattern from Sevenoaks to Ramsgate.

- Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Tonbridge and Ashford International trains are revised to run to and from London Victoria, calling additionally at Bromley South and Orpington, and then as scheduled calling pattern from Sevenoaks to Dover Priory.
- Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells trains will not run.
- Charing Cross to Hastings trains are retimed and on departure from London Bridge are diverted via an alternative route to Orpington, and then as the scheduled calling pattern from Orpington to Hastings. Note: half hourly train frequency to/from Tunbridge Wells will operate all day from start to close of service.
- Charing Cross to Sevenoaks via Grove Park trains will not run.
- Cannon Street to Orpington via Grove Park trains will not run.
- Replacement buses will operate every 15 minutes between Lewisham, Hither Green, Grove Park and all stations to Orpington.
- Grove Park to Bromley North trains will not run.

- Victoria to Orpington via Heme Hill and Bromley South trains are revised and extended to terminate at Tonbridge, calling additionally at Chelsfield, Knockholt, Dunton Green, Sevenoaks and Hildenborough.
- Charing Cross to Hayes trains are retimed and revised to call additionally at Lewisham and run as scheduled between Ladywell and Hayes.
- Cannon Street to Hayes trains will not run.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Cannon Street, Charing Cross, Embankment (for Charing Cross), London Bridge, Southwark (for Waterloo East), Waterloo and Victoria underground stations.
- on following local bus routes, in any direction between Grove Park, Sundridge Park and Bromley North.
 - Grove Park - Bromley North - local bus routes 126 or 261.
 - Grove Park - Sundridge Park - bus 126/261 to Plaistow Green and change for 314.
 - Sundridge Park - Bromley North - local bus 314.
