

Changes to train times

This week

Monday 20 to Friday 24 May

Late night engineering work between Tonbridge and Hastings on Monday and Tuesday nights, certain trains (see list below) in both directions will be replaced by buses between Tonbridge, Tunbridge Wells, Wadhurst and Hastings stations:

- 2200, 2230, 2300, 2330 (Mon) Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells.
- 0025 (Tues) Cannon Street to Tunbridge Wells.
- 2245 & 2345 (Mon & Tues) Charing Cross Street to Hastings.
- 2250 (Mon) Hastings to Tonbridge.
- 0005 & 0035 (Tues) Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge.
- 2305 (Mon) Tunbridge Wells to Cannon Street; starts Tonbridge at 2315; additional buses at 2245/2305/2338 Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge.
- Also, late night connecting minibus services operate between Battle and Crowhurst.

Late night engineering work between Blackheath and Dartford via Bexleyheath will affect the following train services:

- 2352 (Mon to Thurs) & 0026 (Thurs & Fri only) Charing Cross to Dartford via Bexleyheath;
- 2336 (Mon to Thurs) & 0008 (Tues to Fri only) Victoria to Dartford via Bexleyheath;
- 0046 (Tues & Wed only) Cannon Street to Dartford via Bexleyheath.
- All these train services are diverted on departure from Lewisham and will call at Hither Green, Lee, Mottingham, New Eltham, Sidcup, Albany Park, Bexley, Crayford and terminate at Dartford.

Replacement buses will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, calling at Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barnehurst.

- 0012 & 0042 (Thurs & Fri only) Charing Cross to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal services are diverted on departure from Lewisham and will call at Hither Green, Lee, Mottingham, New Eltham, Sidcup, Albany Park, Bexley, Crayford and terminate at Dartford. Replacement buses will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, calling at Blackheath, Charlton, Woolwich Dockyard, Woolwich Arsenal, Plumstead, Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith and Slade Green.
- 0032 (Thurs & Fri only) Cannon Street to Dartford via Woolwich Arsenal scheduled bus service will terminate at Charlton, passengers for stations to Dartford to change for connecting bus service.
- 0102 (Tues & Wed only) Cannon Street to Dartford train are diverted on departure from Lewisham and runs non-stop to Dartford. Replacement buses will operate between Lewisham and Dartford, calling at Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barnehurst.

As a result of engineering work, the following late night trains between Grove Park/Sundridge Park/Bromley North will not run:

- **Grove Park to Bromley North:**
- 2355 (Mon to Thurs), 0015, 0035, 0055 (Tues to Fri)
- **Bromley North to Grove Park:**
- 0004, 0024 & 0044 (Tues to Fri)

Valid train tickets will be accepted for travel on following local bus routes, in any direction between Grove Park, Sundridge Park and Bromley North.

- Grove Park - Bromley North - local bus routes 126 or 261
- Grove Park - Sundridge Park - bus 126/261 to Plaistow Green and change for 314.
- Sundridge Park - Bromley North - local bus 314.

Late night engineering work between Maidstone East and Ashford International will affect the following train services on Monday to Thursday nights:

- 2355 (Mon to Thurs) & 0025 (Tues to Fri) Victoria to Ashford International trains - will terminate at Maidstone East; with replacement buses calling all stations to Ashford International.

Late night engineering work between Sole Street/Strood to Rainham will affect the following train services on Monday to Thursday nights:

- 2315 (Mon, Wed & Thurs) Ramsgate to Gillingham train will terminate at Sittingbourne with connecting replacement bus to Gillingham.
- 2342 (Mon to Thurs) Victoria to Gillingham will terminate at Sole Street, change at Meopham for connecting replacement buses to Rochester, Chatham and Gillingham. Passengers from Sole St travel to Rochester on 0031 bus.
- 2355 (Mon to Thurs) St Pancras to Faversham will terminate at Ebbsfleet Intl, with connecting replacement bus service at 0020 to Faversham.

- 0010 (Tues to Fri) Victoria to Ramsgate will terminate at Meopham with connecting bus to Sittingbourne; connecting with train service departing Sittingbourne at 0208 calling all stations to Ramsgate.
- 0040 Victoria to Gillingham train will terminate at Meopham with connecting bus to Gillingham.
- 0116 (Tues to Fri) Sittingbourne to Ramsgate additional train service will run calling at all stations.

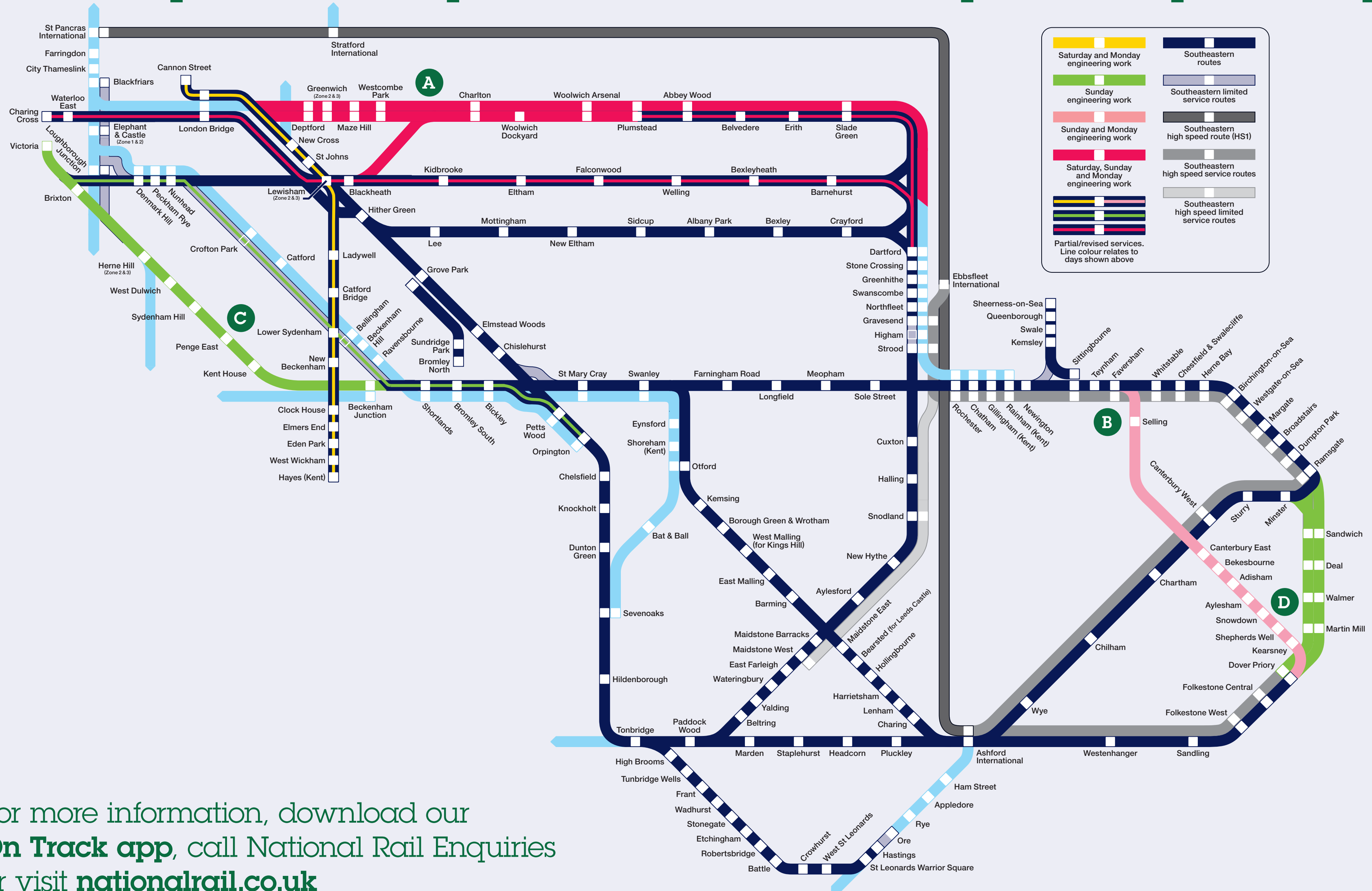
Also, there are no timetabled buses operating in either direction between Faversham and Ramsgate on Tuesday night, the following trains are revised to operate in the scheduled Wednesday to Friday timings:

- 2240 & 2310 Victoria to Ramsgate.
- 2225 St Pancras to Ramsgate via Faversham.
- 2212 & 2312 St Pancras to Ramsgate via Ashford International.

Also,

- 2210 (Tues) Victoria to Dover Priory train is retimed to depart Faversham at 2334 and Canterbury East at 2348 and setting down only at intermediate stations to Dover Priory, arriving at 0016.
- 2248 (Tues) Ramsgate to Faversham train is revised to depart at 2315 and terminate at Sittingbourne with connecting replacement bus to Gillingham. (Note: 2315 Ramsgate to Gillingham bus service will not run.)
- 2310 (Tues) Dover to Gillingham will terminate at Faversham, change for connecting services.

A Saturday timetable will operate on Bank Holiday Mon 27 May

Engineering work is taking place between Deptford/Blackheath to Plumstead via Charlton on Saturday 25 May and Bank Holiday Monday 27 May. As a result:

- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup and Greenwich trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Barnehurst via Greenwich trains **will not run**.
- Cannon Street to Slade Green via Bexleyheath trains **will not run**.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Lewisham and Woolwich Arsenal trains **will not run**. Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Plumstead and Dartford, calling at Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith, and Slade Green.
- Additional trains will operate a half hourly timetable between Cannon Street and Dartford via Bexleyheath, calling at London Bridge, New Cross, St. Johns, Lewisham and all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford.
- Charing Cross to Hayes trains will call additionally at Lewisham all day.

Note: Kentish Town to Rainham via London Bridge and Woolwich Arsenal (GTR) trains are revised to start from Blackfriars, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, Blackheath, Eltham, Bexleyheath, Barnehurst and then as scheduled from Dartford to Rainham.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) services between Greenwich and Lewisham.

Engineering work is taking place between Deptford/Blackheath to Plumstead via Charlton Woolwich Arsenal on Sunday, 26 May. As a result:

- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich and Sidcup trains **will not run**.
- Charing Cross to Dartford via Lewisham and Woolwich Arsenal trains will operate as scheduled to Blackheath and are diverted to call additionally at all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath.
- Replacement buses will operate a half hourly timetable between Lewisham and Plumstead, calling at St. Johns, New Cross, Deptford, Greenwich, Maze Hill, Westcombe Park, Charlton and all stations to Plumstead via Woolwich Arsenal.
- Additional trains will operate a half hourly timetable between Plumstead and Dartford, calling at Abbey Wood, Belvedere, Erith, and Slade Green.
- Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup trains are retimed and will run in scheduled stopping pattern to Crayford and then diverted to terminate at Dartford.
- Victoria to Dartford via Lewisham and Bexleyheath trains will run as scheduled.
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains will call additionally at Lewisham and will then run as scheduled from Hither Green.

Note: Kentish Town to Rainham via London Bridge and Woolwich Arsenal (GTR) trains are revised to start from Blackfriars, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, Blackheath, Eltham, Bexleyheath, Barnehurst and then as scheduled from Dartford to Rainham.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- on the Docklands Light Railway (DLR) services between Greenwich and Lewisham.

Engineering work is taking place between Faversham and Dover Priory on Sunday 26 May. As a result:

- Victoria to Ramsgate and Dover Priory trains will not detach a portion at Faversham and trains will run through to Ramsgate.
- A replacement bus service will operate between Faversham, Canterbury East and Dover Priory only; a second replacement bus service will operate an hourly timetable between Canterbury East and Dover Priory, calling at Bekesbourne, Adisham, Aylesford, Snowdown, Shepherds Well and Kearsney; a minibus service operates between Faversham and Selling.
- Victoria to Canterbury East trains are revised to terminate at Faversham.

Engineering work is taking place between Faversham and Dover Priory on Bank Holiday Monday 27 May. As a result:

- Victoria to Dover Priory trains will terminate at Faversham.
- A replacement bus service will operate between Faversham, Canterbury East and Dover Priory; a second replacement bus service will operate an hourly timetable between Canterbury East and Dover Priory, calling at Bekesbourne, Adisham, Aylesford, Snowdown, Shepherds Well and Kearsney; a minibus service operates between Faversham and Selling.
- Victoria to Dover Priory via Denmark Hill trains are revised to terminate at Faversham.
- A replacement bus service will operate between Faversham, Canterbury East and Dover Priory only.

Engineering work is taking place between Brixton and Shortlands via Heme Hill on Sunday 26 May. As a result:

- Victoria to Orpington via Heme Hill trains, on departure from Victoria, are revised and diverted calling additionally at Denmark Hill, and then run non-stop to Shortlands and as scheduled between Bromley South and Orpington.
- Replacement buses will operate between Denmark Hill and Bromley South, calling at Heme Hill, West Dulwich (Croxted Road), Sydenham Hill, Penge East, Kent House, Beckenham Junction and Shortlands.

Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:

- Passengers travelling to/from Brixton, holding valid train tickets to use the London Underground Victoria line services between Victoria and Brixton.

Engineering work is taking place between Dover Priory and Ramsgate on Sunday 26 May. As a result:

- St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Ashford International and Dover Priory trains are revised to terminate at Dover Priory, with connecting replacement buses between Dover Priory and Ramsgate calling at Martin Mill, Walmer, Deal and Sandwich.
- St Pancras International to Dover Priory via Faversham trains are revised to terminate at Ramsgate, with connecting replacement buses calling at all stations between Ramsgate and Dover Priory.
