

Changes to train times

This week

Tuesday 4 to Friday 7 May

A revised train timetable is in operation as a result of the coronavirus, and will be amended by late night engineering work. Please check before you travel, using the online journey planners.

Late night engineering work will affect the following train services between:

Sole Street/Strood to Rainham

- 2342 (Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday only) Victoria to Gillingham train will terminate at Sole Street at 0031 (Wednesday, Thursday & Friday only), a connecting replacement bus service to Gillingham departs Meopham at 0038 calling at Rochester and Chatham.
- 0040 (Wednesday to Friday only) Victoria to Gillingham train will terminate at Meopham at 0121; a connecting replacement bus service to Gillingham departs Meopham at 0130, setting down passengers at Rochester and Chatham.
- 0418 (Wednesday to Friday only) Gillingham to Paddock Wood train is revised to start from Strood at 0434 and then as scheduled calling pattern to Paddock Wood. A connecting replacement bus service to Strood, departs Gillingham at 0400, Chatham 0411, Rochester 0418, arriving Strood at 0425.

Faversham to Ramsgate

On Tuesday night (4 May), there are no scheduled bus services operating between Faversham and Ramsgate, the following trains are revised to operate in the scheduled Wednesday to Friday timings:

- 2210 & 2310 (Tuesday only) Victoria to Ramsgate.

Lewisham to Dartford via Bexleyheath

As a result of late night engineering work between the above stations, the following train services are revised:

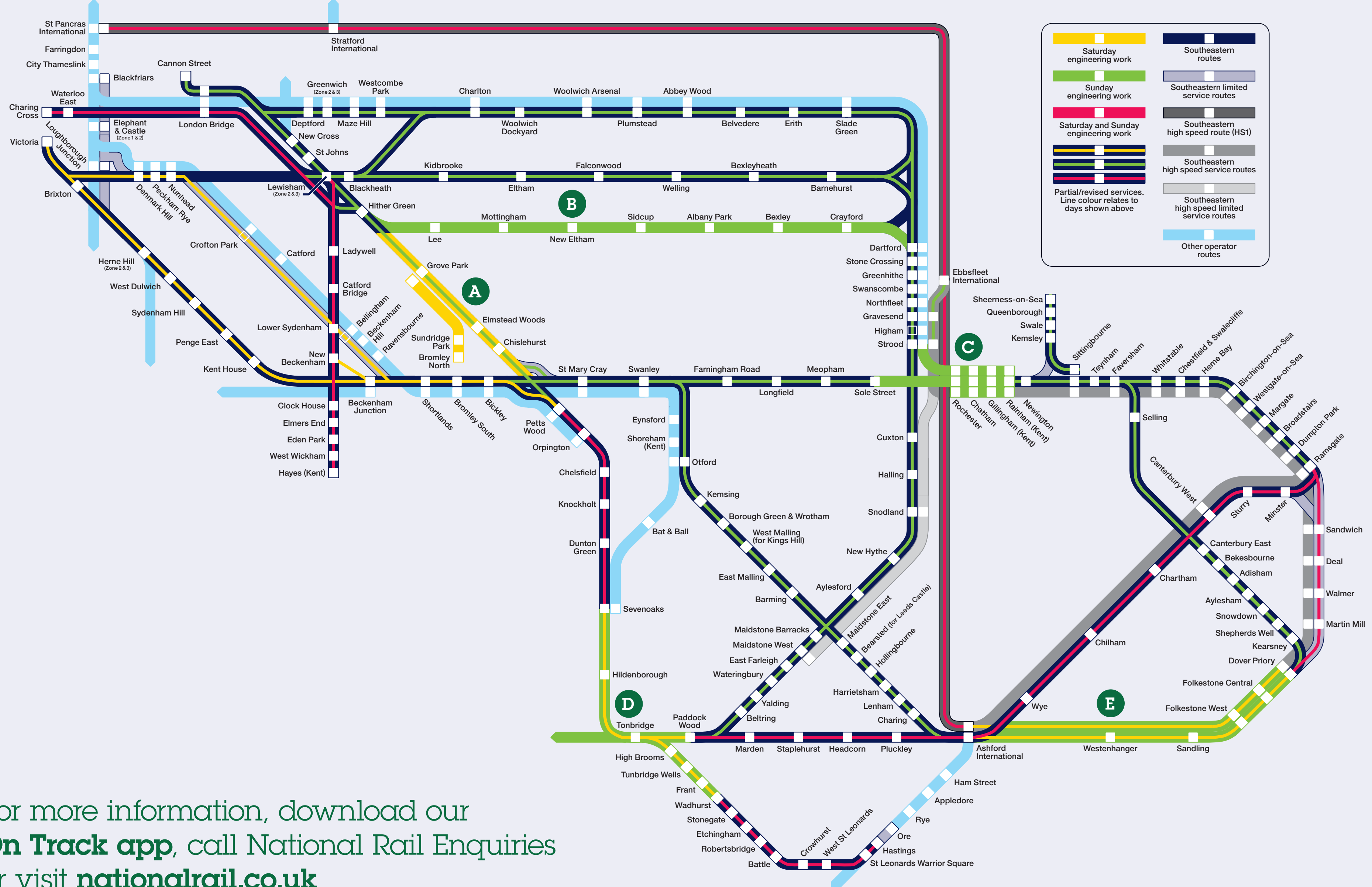
- 2354 (Tuesday to Thursday only) Charing Cross to Dartford via Bexleyheath.
- 0004 (Wednesday to Friday only) Victoria to Dartford via Lewisham and Bexleyheath.

These trains will run as scheduled to Lewisham and then diverted via alternative route to Dartford. Connecting replacement bus services will depart Lewisham at 0022 & 0036 (Tuesday to Friday only) to Dartford, calling at Blackheath, Kidbrooke, Eltham, Falconwood, Welling, Bexleyheath and Barnehurst.

Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 May

- A** Engineering work is taking place on Saturday 8 May between Hither Green and Petts Wood: Grove Park and Bromley North. There are no train services calling at Grove Park, Sundridge Park, Bromley North, Elmstead Woods and Chislehurst stations on Saturday 8 May. As a result:
- Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Tonbridge and Canterbury West trains are revised to start from Victoria at 01 minute past the hour, running non-stop to Orpington then as scheduled calling pattern from Orpington to Ramsgate via Tonbridge and Canterbury West.
 - Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Tonbridge and Ashford International trains are revised to start from Victoria at 31 minutes past the hour, running non-stop to Orpington then as scheduled calling pattern from Orpington to Dover Priory via Ashford International and further revised to call at Martin Mill, Walmer, Deal, Sandwich and terminates at Ramsgate.
 - Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells trains will not run.
 - Charing Cross to Hastings trains are revised to depart from Charing Cross at 05 & 35 minutes past the hour, and on departure from London Bridge are diverted via an alternative route to Orpington and these trains then call at Orpington, Sevenoaks, Hildenborough (hourly), Tonbridge and then as scheduled calling pattern to Hastings.
 - Charing Cross to Sevenoaks via Grove Park trains will not run.
 - Cannon Street to Orpington via Grove Park trains will not run.
 - Replacement buses will operate every 15 minutes between Lewisham, Hither Green, Grove Park, Elmstead Woods, Chislehurst, Petts Wood and Orpington. **Note:** * = half hourly bus service only.
 - Grove Park to Bromley North trains will not run: use local TfL buses, see below.
 - Victoria to Orpington via Herne Hill and Bromley South trains are revised to call additionally at Chelsfield, Knockholt, Dunton Green and terminate at Sevenoaks.
 - Cannon Street to Hayes via Lewisham trains will run as scheduled.
 - Charing Cross to Hayes trains will not run.
- Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:**
- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Cannon Street, Charing Cross, Embankment (for Charing Cross), London Bridge, Southwark (for Waterloo East), Waterloo and Victoria underground stations.

- on following local TfL bus routes, in any direction between Grove Park, Sundridge Park and Bromley North:
 - Grove Park - Bromley North - local bus routes 126 or 261.
 - Grove Park - Sundridge Park - bus 126/261 to Plaistow Green and change for 314.
 - Sundridge Park - Bromley North - local bus 314.
- B** Engineering work is taking place on Sunday 9 May between Hither Green to Dartford via Sidcup. There are no train services calling at Lee, Mottingham, New Eltham, Sidcup, Albany Park, Bexley and Crayford stations on Sunday 9 May. As a result:
- Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are diverted to call at Lewisham, and call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Dartford and then call at Stone Crossing, Greenhithe, Swanscombe, Northfleet and terminate at Gravesend.
 - Replacement buses will operate half hourly between Lewisham, Hither Green, Lee, Mottingham, New Eltham, Sidcup, Albany Park - (Hurst Road), Bexley, Crayford and Dartford.
 - Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Sidcup, Slade Green and Greenwich trains are revised to depart at 18 & 48 minutes past the hour and diverted on departure from Lewisham, calling at all stations via Bexleyheath to Slade Green and then as scheduled calling pattern to Cannon Street.
 - Cannon Street to Cannon Street via Greenwich, Slade Green and Sidcup trains will run as scheduled to Slade Green and then diverted to call at all stations via Bexleyheath to Lewisham and then as scheduled calling pattern to Cannon Street.
- C** Engineering work is taking place on Sunday 9 May between Sole Street/Strood and Rainham. There are no train services calling at Rochester, Chatham and Gillingham stations on Sunday 9 May. As a result:
- Victoria to Ramsgate & Dover Priory trains will run as scheduled to Bromley South, calling additionally at Meopham and terminates at Sole Street. Replacement bus services will operate between Meopham, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham and Rainham.
 - Additional train services will operate between Rainham and Ramsgate, calling at Sittingbourne, Faversham, Whitstable, Chestfield & Swalecliffe, Herne Bay, Birchington-on-Sea, Westgate-on-Sea, Margate, Broadstairs and Dumpton Park.

- Note:** passengers travelling from Sole Street for Medway towns and stations to Dover Priory and Ramsgate should circulate via Meopham and connect with replacement bus services.
 - Victoria to Canterbury East via Denmark Hill trains are revised to depart Victoria at 56 minutes past the hour, calling in scheduled calling pattern and revised to terminate at Sole Street.
 - A replacement bus service will operate between Meopham, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham and Rainham. Additional train services will operate between Rainham and Dover Priory, calling at Newington, Sittingbourne, Teynham, Faversham, Sittingbourne, Canterbury East, Bekebourne, Adisham, Aylesham, Snowdown, Shepherds Well and Kearsney.
 - Note:** passengers travelling from Sole Street for Medway towns and stations to Dover Priory and Ramsgate should circulate via Meopham and connect with replacement bus services.
 - Sittingbourne to Sheerness-on-Sea trains are revised.
 - St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Strood and Faversham trains will call additionally at Higham and terminate at Strood, connecting with replacement buses from Strood to Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham and Rainham; with connecting trains from Rainham to Ramsgate and Dover Priory.
 - St Pancras International to Faversham via Strood trains will not run.
 - Charing Cross to Gravesend via Sidcup trains are revised to call at Lewisham and revised to call at all stations via Bexleyheath and Dartford to Gravesend.
 - Note:** Kentish Town to Rainham Thameslink trains are revised to terminate at Gravesend.
- D** Engineering work is taking place on Sunday 9 May, between Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and Paddock Wood: Tonbridge and Wadhurst. There are no train services operating from/to Hildenborough, Tonbridge, High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells and Frant stations on Sunday 9 May. As a result:
- Charing Cross to Hastings trains are revised to terminate at Sevenoaks.
 - Connecting replacement bus services will operate from Sevenoaks on the following routes:
 - Half hourly between Sevenoaks, Hildenborough, Tonbridge, High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells, Frant and Wadhurst.
 - Half hourly between Sevenoaks, Tonbridge and Paddock Wood.

- Revised train services will operate a half hourly timetable between:
 - Wadhurst and Hastings, calling at Stonegate, Etchingham, Robertsbridge, Battle, Crowhurst, West St Leonards and St Leonards Warrior Square.
 - Paddock Wood and Ashford International, calling at Marden, Staplehurst, Headcorn and Pluckley.
 - Also, Tonbridge to Strood trains are revised to start from Paddock Wood and run as scheduled calling pattern; replacement buses operate hourly between Tonbridge and Paddock Wood.
 - Charing Cross to Ramsgate via Ashford International and Canterbury West trains are diverted on departure from London Bridge calling at Chislehurst, Otford and Maidstone East, Ashford International, Wye, Chilham, Chartham, Canterbury West, Sturry, Minster and Ramsgate.
 - Charing Cross to Dover Priory trains will not run, see note E.
- E** Engineering work is taking place on Sunday 9 May between Ashford International and Dover Priory. There are no train services calling at Westenanger, Sandling, Folkestone West and Folkestone Central stations on Sunday 9 May. As a result:
- Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Tonbridge and Ashford International trains will not run.
 - St Pancras International to Ramsgate via Ashford International and Dover Priory trains are revised to terminate at Ashford International.
 - Replacement buses will operate an hourly service between Ashford International, Folkestone West, Folkestone Central and Dover Priory.
 - An hourly train service will operate between Dover Priory and Ramsgate, calling at Martin Mill, Walmer, Deal and Sandwich.
 - Charing Cross to Dover Priory via Tonbridge and Ashford International trains will not run.
 - Note:** Westenanger is served by an hourly minibus service operating in both directions between Westenanger and Sandling, connecting with replacement buses between Ashford International and Dover Priory.
