

# Changes to train times

## This week

### Monday 22 to Friday 26 December

#### Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 December

- A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes with the following alterations:**
- 0519 Tonbridge to Charing Cross will depart earlier at 0457.
  - 1641, 1704 and 1741 Cannon Street to Ramsgate services will run, calling at London Bridge, Rochester and then all stations to Ramsgate, except Newington and Teynham.
  - 0527, 0605 and 0627 Ramsgate to Cannon Street services will run, calling at all stations to Rochester, except Teynham and Newington and then London Bridge and Cannon Street.
  - 0630, 0730 and 0830 Hastings to Charing Cross services will depart earlier at 0619, 0719 and 0817, call at all stations to Tunbridge Wells and then call as scheduled.
  - 1615, 1715, 1815 and 1915 Charing Cross to Hastings services, will run as scheduled to Tunbridge Wells and then call at all stations to Hastings.
  - 0528 Hayes to Charing Cross will depart earlier at 0513.
  - 0600 London Bridge to Cannon Street additional service will run.
  - 0505 Ramsgate to St Pancras International will depart earlier at 0450, call at all stations to Ashford International via Canterbury West, and then call as scheduled.
  - 0600 Faversham to St Pancras International will start from Broadstairs at 0524, calling at all stations to Herne Bay, Whitstable, Faversham and then run as scheduled.

After 2330, Charing Cross services will be diverted to and from Cannon Street.

#### Wednesday 24 December – Christmas Eve

- A scheduled Saturday service will operate on all Southeastern routes with the following alterations:**
- 0519 Tonbridge to Charing Cross will depart earlier at 0457.
  - 1641, 1704 and 1741 Cannon Street to Ramsgate services will run, calling at London Bridge, Rochester and then all stations to Ramsgate, except Newington and Teynham.
  - 0527, 0605 and 0627 Ramsgate to Cannon Street services will run, calling at all stations to Rochester, except Teynham and Newington and then London Bridge and Cannon Street.
  - 0630, 0730 and 0830 Hastings to Charing Cross services will depart earlier at 0619, 0719 and 0817, call at all stations to Tunbridge Wells and then call as scheduled.
  - 1615, 1715, 1815 and 1915 Charing Cross to Hastings services, will run as scheduled to Tunbridge Wells and then call at all stations to Hastings.
  - 0528 Hayes to Charing Cross will depart earlier at 0513.
  - 0600 London Bridge to Cannon Street additional service will run.
  - 0505 Ramsgate to St Pancras International will depart earlier at 0450, call at all stations to Ashford International via Canterbury West, and then call as scheduled.
  - 0600 Faversham to St Pancras International will start from Broadstairs at 0524, calling at all stations to Herne Bay, Whitstable, Faversham and then run as scheduled.

All Southeastern services, will shut down earlier, with a reduced frequency from 2100 and no trains running after 2200.

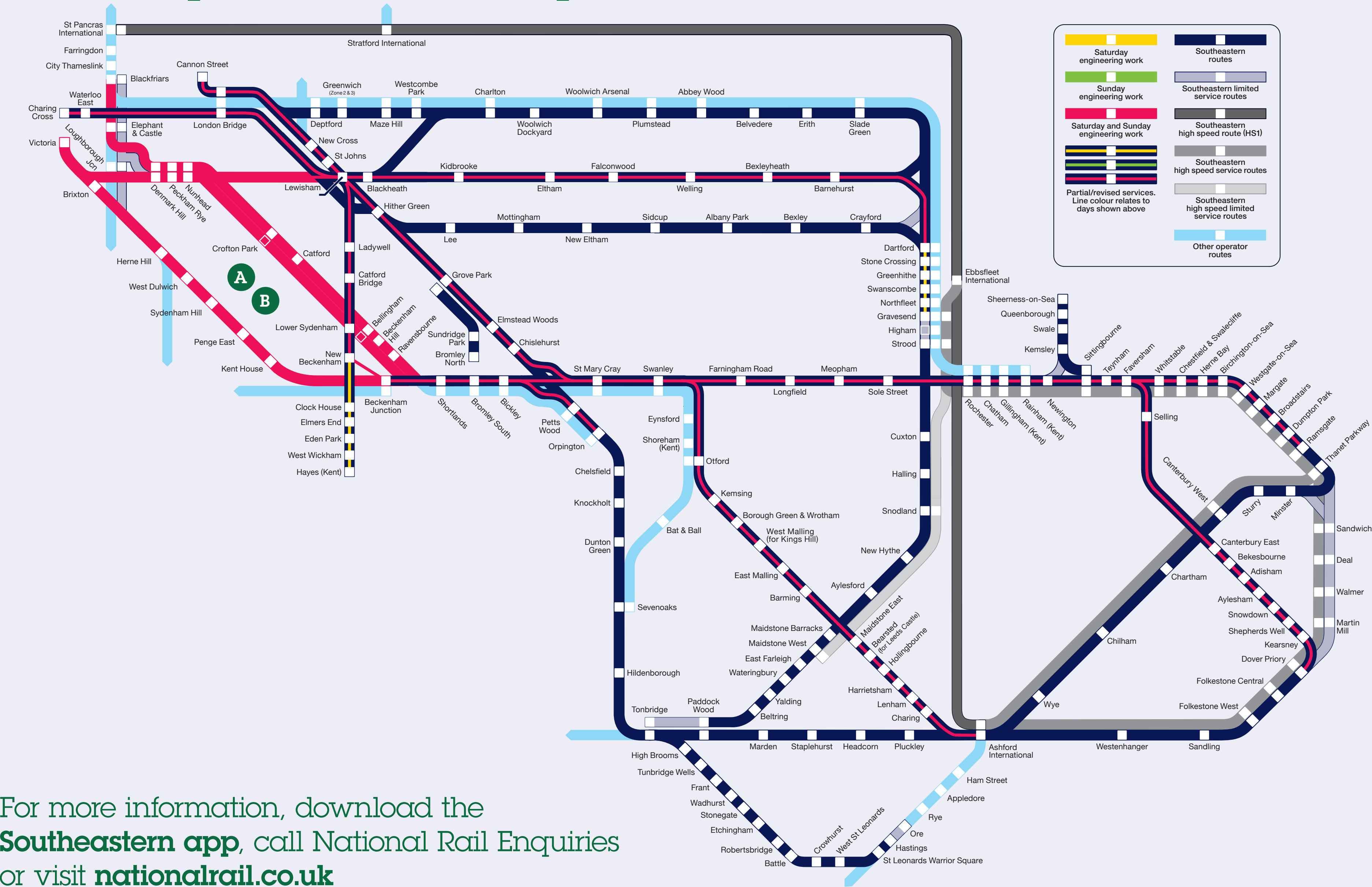

**Engineering work is taking place between Victoria and Beckenham Junction via Herne Hill/Lewisham; and between Blackfriars and Bellingham on Saturday 27 December**

- 10 minutes past the hour Victoria to Dover Priory services, will run from Cannon Street at 05 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Longfield and then run as scheduled.
- 40 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ramsgate services, will run from Cannon Street at 37 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Rochester and then run as scheduled.
- 55 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ashford International via Maidstone East services, **will not run**.
- Train services will depart from Charing Cross at 59 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, St Mary Cray, Swanley, Otford and all stations to Ashford International.
- 42 minutes past the hour Victoria to Gillingham services, will run from Cannon Street at 39 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Bromley South, St Mary Cray, Swanley and all stations to Gillingham.
- Train services will depart from Cannon Street at 09 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Bromley South, St Mary Cray and Swanley.
- 03 and 33 minutes past the hour Victoria to Gravesend via Bexleyheath services, **will not run**.
- Train services will depart from Charing Cross at 25 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham and all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath.
- 27 and 57 minutes past the hour Victoria to Orpington services, **will not run**.
- 08 and 38 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hayes services, will run as scheduled to New Beckenham, then call at Beckenham Junction, Shortlands, Bromley South, Bickley, Petts Wood and Orpington.
- A replacement bus service will run from Denmark Hill, calling at all stations to Beckenham Junction via Herne Hill.
- 18 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Victoria services, will run as scheduled to Rochester and then be diverted to London Bridge and Cannon Street.

- Train services will depart from Ashford International at 05 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Otford, then Swanley, St Mary Cray, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- Train services will depart from Gillingham at 15 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to St Mary Cray, Bromley South, London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- Train services will depart from Swanley at 19 minutes past the hour, calling at St Mary Cray, Bromley South, London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- 20 and 50 minutes past the hour Gravesend to Victoria via Bexleyheath services, **will not run**.
- Train services will depart from Dartford at 23 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Lewisham via Bexleyheath, then London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- 28 and 58 minutes past the hour Hayes to Charing Cross services, will start from Orpington at 20 and 50 minutes past the hour, calling at Petts Wood, Bickley, Bromley South, Shortlands, Beckenham Junction, New Beckenham and then run as scheduled to Charing Cross.

**Engineering work is taking place between Victoria and Beckenham Junction via Herne Hill/Lewisham; and between Blackfriars and Bellingham on Saturday 27 December**

- 40 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ramsgate services, will run from Cannon Street at 41 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Rochester and then run as scheduled.
- 12 minutes past the hour Victoria to Dover Priory services, will run from Cannon Street at 10 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, be diverted non-stop to Bromley South and then run as scheduled.
- 55 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ashford International services, will run from Cannon Street at 52 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, St Mary Cray, Swanley, Otford and then run as scheduled.
- 27 and 57 minutes past the hour Victoria to Orpington services, will start from Charing Cross at 17 and 47 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Ladywell, Catford Bridge, Lower Sydenham, New Beckenham, Beckenham Junction and then run as scheduled.
- A replacement bus service will run from Denmark Hill, calling at all stations to Beckenham Junction via Herne Hill.
- 03 and 33 minutes past the hour Victoria to Dartford services, **will not run**.
- Train services will depart from Charing Cross at 25 and 55 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham and all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath.
- 53 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to Victoria services, will run as scheduled to Rochester and then be diverted to London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- 50 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Victoria services, will depart at 37 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled to Bromley South and then be diverted to London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- 56 minutes past the hour Ashford International to Victoria services, will run as scheduled to St Mary Cray and then be diverted to London Bridge and Cannon Street.
- 20 and 50 minutes past the hour Orpington to Victoria services, will call as scheduled to Beckenham Junction and then be diverted to New Beckenham, Lower Sydenham, Catford Bridge, Ladywell, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- A replacement bus service will run from Beckenham Junction, calling at all stations to Denmark Hill via Herne Hill.
- 02 and 32 minutes past the hour Dartford to Victoria services, **will not run**.
- Train services will depart from Dartford at 23 and 53 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Lewisham via Bexleyheath, then London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
