

# Changes to train times

## This week

Monday 28 July to Friday 1 August

Engineering work will affect the following late night services:

**Mondays from 2345** - Ashford to Minster via Canterbury West line is closed. Replacement bus services will run from Ashford and alternative train services to Ramsgate only.

**Tuesdays from 2325** - Faversham to Ramsgate via Herne Bay line is closed. Replacement bus services will run from Faversham and alternative train services to Ramsgate only.

**Mondays and Tuesdays from 2340** - Charing Cross to London Bridge line is closed. Train services will run from Cannon Street.

**Wednesdays and Thursdays from 2345** - Cannon Street to London Bridge line is closed  
Train services will run from Charing Cross.

**Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday morning only**

- 0435 Swanley to Victoria will start from Bromley South at 0448. A replacement bus service will run from Swanley at 0357, calling at St Mary Cray, Bickley and Bromley South.
- 0854 Cannon Street to Ramsgate additional service will run, calling at Greenwich, all stations to Slade Green, Dartford, Greenhithe, Gravesend, Strood, Rochester, Chatham, Gillingham, Rainham, Sittingbourne, Faversham, Whitstable, Heme Bay, Margate, Broadstairs and Ramsgate.

**Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday only**

- 1453 Sittingbourne to Sheerness-on-Sea **will not run.**
- 1517 Sheerness-on-Sea to Sittingbourne **will not run.**

- 2156 Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms and Tunbridge Wells.
- 2226 Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms and Tunbridge Wells.
- 2245 Charing Cross to Hastings will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells and Wadhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells to Frant. A train service will run from Frant to Hastings, calling at all stations to Hastings.
- 2250 Hastings to Tonbridge will terminate at Wadhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Wadhurst, calling at Frant, Tunbridge Wells, High Brooms and Tonbridge.
- 2305 Tunbridge Wells to Cannon Street will start from Tonbridge at 2319. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at High Brooms and Tonbridge.
- 2305 Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge will terminate bus service will run, calling at High Brooms and Tonbridge.

- 2315 Charing Cross to Tunbridge Wells will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms and Tunbridge Wells.
- 2349 Cannon Street to Hastings will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells, Wadhurst(s), Battle(s), West St Leonards(s), St Leonards Warrior Square(s) and Hastings. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Cannon Street(s) to Tonbridge.
- 0020 Cannon Street to Tunbridge Wells will terminate at Tonbridge. A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at High Brooms(s) and Tunbridge Wells.
- 0020 Tunbridge Wells to Tonbridge **will not run**. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at High Brooms and Tonbridge.

**Monday and Tuesday only**

2353 Cannon Street to Gravesend will run, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath and then all stations(s) to Gravesend.

A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at Hither Green, all stations to Dartford(s) via and then all stations(s) to Gravesend.

Gravesend Station to Gravesend will run, calling at London Bridge, Lewisham, all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath, Stone Crossing(s), Greenhithe(s), Swanscomb(s), Northlee(s) and Gravesend. A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at Hither Green, all stations to Dartford(s) via Sidcup and then all stations(s) to Gravesend.

**Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday only**

- 2347 Levinsham to Dartford replacement bus service will run, calling at Hither Green and all stations to Dartford via Sidcup.
- 0025 Victoria to Ashford International will depart at 0040, calling at Bromley South, Sevenoaks, Tonbridge, Hastings and Ashford International. A replacement bus service will run from Bromley South, calling at St Mary Cray, Swanley, Borough Green & Wrotham, West Malling(s), Barming(s), Maidstone East(s), Bearsted(s), Lenham(s) and Ashford International.
- 0040 Victoria to Gillingham will run, calling at Rochester(s), Chatham(s) and Gillingham. A replacement bus service will run from Bromley South, calling at St Mary Cray(s), Swanley(s), Farningham Roads, Longfield(s), Meopham(s), Rochester(s), Chatham(s) and Gillingham.
- 0127 Maidstone East to Ashford International replacement bus service will run, calling at Bearsted(s), Lenham(s) and Ashford International.

**Tuesday only**

- 2245 Charing Cross to Hastings will terminate at Tunbridge Wells. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Wadhurst(s), Battle(s), West St Leonards(s), St Leonards Warrior Square(s) and Hastings. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at all stations(s) to Robertsbridge.
- 2300 Tonbridge Street Hastings will terminate at Tunbridge Wells. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at Wadhurst(s), Battle(s), West St Leonards(s), St Leonards Warrior Square(s) and Hastings. A replacement minibus service will run between Battle and Crowhurst. A replacement bus service will run from Tunbridge Wells, calling at all stations(s) to Robertsbridge.

**Wednesday and Thursday only**

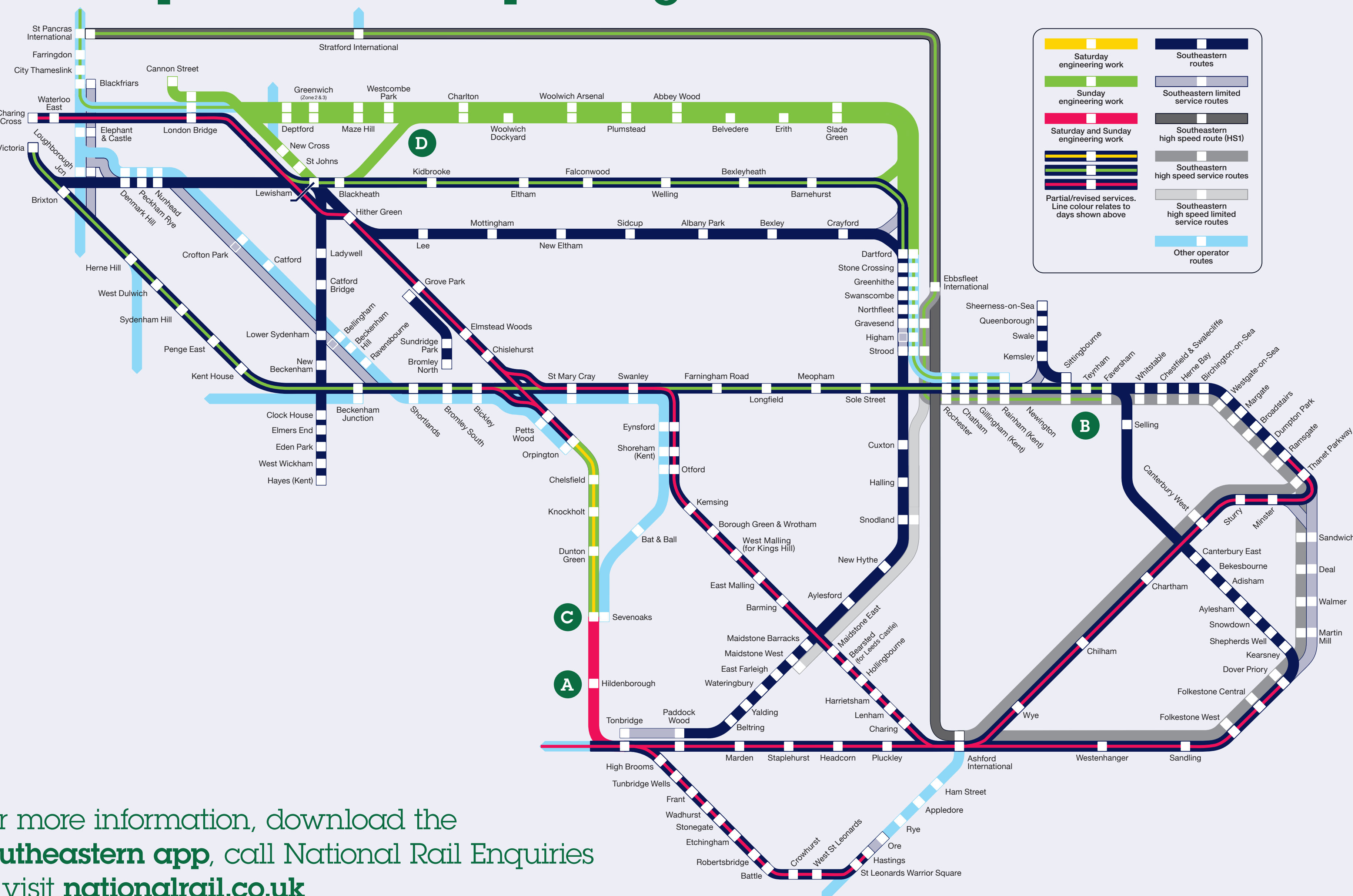
- 2350 Charing Cross to Gravesend will run, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham, all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath and then all stations(s) to Gravesend. A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at Hither Green, all stations to Dartford via Sidcup and then all stations(s) to Gravesend.
- 2330 Dartford to Gravesend will run, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Lewisham, all stations to Dartford via Bexleyheath and then all stations(s) to Gravesend. A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at Hither Green, all stations to Dartford via Sidcup and then all stations(s) to Gravesend.

**Friday only**

- 2205 Ramsgate to Victoria will depart at 2230, calling at Dumpton Park, Broadstairs, Margate, Westgate-on-Sea, Birchington-on-Sea, Herne Bay, Chatham & Swalecliffe, Whitstable, Ravensham, Teynham, Sittingbourne, Newington, Gillingham, Gillingham, Chatham, Rochester, Sole Street, Meopham, Longfield, Farningham Road, Swanley, St Mary Cray, Bromley South and Victoria.
- 2315 Margate to Gillingham will run, calling at all stations to Gillingham, then Bromley South/s and Victoria.

## Saturday 2 August

### Engineering work is taking place between Tonbridge and Sevenoaks on Saturday 2 August

- 15 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hastings services, will depart at 34 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, then be diverted to run non-stop to Tonbridge, where the train will divide:
  - The front portion will depart at 42 minutes past the hour, for High Brooms, Tunbridge Wells, Wadhurst, Battle, St Leonards Warrior Square and Hastings.
  - The rear portion will depart at 44 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ashford International.
- 45 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hastings services, will depart at 04 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, then be diverted to run non-stop to Tonbridge, where the train will divide:
  - The front portion will depart at 12 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Hastings.
  - The rear portion will depart at 14 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ashford International.
- 04 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Dover Priory services, **will not run**.
- 29 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Margate services, **will not run**.
- 34 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Ramsgate services, will depart at 29 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Swanley, Otford, Borough Green & Wrotham, Maidstone East, then Ashford International, where the train will divide:
  - The front portion will depart at 57 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ramsgate via Canterbury West.
  - The rear portion will depart at 59 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Dover Priory.
- Train services will depart from Charing Cross at 15 and 45 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Ovingington and Sevenoaks only.
- A replacement bus service will run from Sevenoaks, calling at Hildenborough and Tonbridge only.
- 31 minutes past the hour Hastings to Charing Cross services, will call as scheduled to Tonbridge and then run non-stop to London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- 50 minutes past the hour Hastings to Charing Cross services, will depart at 44 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled to Tonbridge and then run non-stop to London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- Train services will depart from Ashford International at 17 and 47 minutes past the hour, calling at stations to Tonbridge, to attach to the above services to Charing Cross.
- 42 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to Charing Cross services, will depart at 33 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled to Ashford International and then be diverted, calling at Maidstone East, West Malling, Borough Green & Wrotham, Otford, Swanley, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- Train services will depart from Dover Priory at 52 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Ashford International, to attach to the above service to Charing Cross.
- 28 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Charing Cross services, **will not run**.
- 14 minutes past the hour Maidstone East to Charing Cross services, **will not run**.
- The services which depart from Sevenoaks at 29 and 59 minutes past the hour, calling at Ovingington, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at Hildenborough and Sevenoaks only.

**B**

Engineering work is taking place between Gillingham and Faversham on Sunday 3 August (until 0700)

- 0645 Faversham to Victoria, will start from Gillingham and then run as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Faversham at 0610 calling at all stations (except Teynham) to Gillingham.
- 0700 Faversham to St Pancras International, will call additionally at Teynham and Newington.

**C** Engineering work is taking place between Orpington and Tonbridge on Sunday 3 August

- 34 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Ramsgate services, will depart at 29 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, Otford, Maidstone East and Ashford International, where the train will divide:

- The front portion will depart at 59 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ramsgate.
- The rear portion will depart at 59 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Dover Priory.
- 04 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Dover Priory services, **will not run**.
- 15 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hastings services, will depart at 04 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, then be diverted to run non-stop to Tonbridge, where the train will divide:
  - The front portion will depart at 05 minutes past the hour, for High Brooms.

- Tunbridge Wells, Wadhurst, Battle, St Leonards Warrior Square and Hastings.
- The rear portion will depart at 07 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ashford International.
- 45 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Hastings services, will depart at 34 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge, then be diverted to run non-stop to Tonbridge, where the train will divide:
  - The front portion will depart at 35 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Hastings.
  - The rear portion will depart at 37 minutes past the hour, for all stations to Ashford International.

- Train services will depart from Charing Cross at 26 and 56 minutes past the hour, calling at Waterloo East, London Bridge and Orpington only. A replacement bus service will run from Orpington, calling at Sevenoaks and Tonbridge only.
- 01 and 31 minutes past the hour Charing Cross to Sevenoaks services, will terminate at Orpington. A replacement bus service will run from Orpington, calling at all stations to Tonbridge.
- 55 minutes past the hour Victoria to Ashford International services, will call additionally at Eynsford and Shoreham.

- 42 minutes past the hour Ramsgate to Charing Cross services, will run as scheduled to Ashford International, then call at Maidstone East, Otford, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- Train services will depart from Dover Priory at 00 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Ashford International, to attach to the above service to Charing Cross.

- 56 minutes past the hour Ashford International to Victoria via Maidstone East services, will call occasionally at Shoreham and Fynsford.
- 28 minutes past the hour Dover Priory to Charing Cross services, **will not run.**
- 31 minutes past the hour Hastings to Charing Cross services, **will depart** at 50 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled to Tonbridge and then non-stop to London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- 50 minutes past the hour Hastings to Charing Cross services, will depart at 07 minutes past the hour, calling as scheduled to Tonbridge and then non-stop to London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross.
- Train services will depart from Ashford International at 07 and 37 minutes past the hour, calling at all stations to Tonbridge, to attach to the above services to Charing Cross.
- A replacement bus service will run from Tonbridge, calling at Sevenoaks and Orpington only.
- Train services will depart from Orpington at 20 and 50 minutes past the hour, calling at London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross only.
- 20 and 50 minutes past the hour Sevenoaks to Charing Cross services, will start from Orpington at 06 and 36 minutes past the hour, calling at Petts Wood, Chislehurst, Elmsted Woods, Grove Park, Hither Green, Lewisham, London Bridge, Waterloo East and Charing Cross..
- A replacement bus service will run from Orpington, calling at all stations to Orpington.

**D** Engineering work is taking place between Deptford/Blackheath and Dartford via Greenwich/Woolwich on Sunday 3 August

**No Southeastern services will run to/from Cannon Street.**

26 and 56 minutes past the hour: Kentish Town to Rainham Thameslink services, will run as scheduled to London Bridge and then be diverted, calling at Lewisham, Blackheath, Eitham, Bexleyheath, Barnehurst, Dartford and then run as scheduled. A replacement bus service will run from Lewisham, calling at all stations to Dartford via New Cross, Greenwich and Woolwich. Please note the 26 and 31 minutes past the hour: Charing Cross to Orpington services, to connect with this bus service at Lewisham.

28 and 58 minutes past the hour: Rainham to Kentish Town Thameslink services, will run as scheduled to Dartford and then be diverted, calling at Barnehurst, Bexleyheath, Blackheath, Lewisham, London Bridge and then run as scheduled.

A replacement bus service will run from London Bridge, calling at all stations to Lewisham via Woolwich, Greenwich and New Cross.

**Valid train tickets will be accepted as follows:**

- on London Underground by any reasonable route, between Charing Cross, Embankment, Southwark, London Bridge and Cannon Street underground stations
- on Docklands Light Railway between Greenwich and Lewisham.

**Bikes on rail replacement bus services**  
You won't be able to carry a bike onto a replacement bus service, but might be able to fit a folding bike in the luggage area if there's enough space.
