Where to access PlusBike?

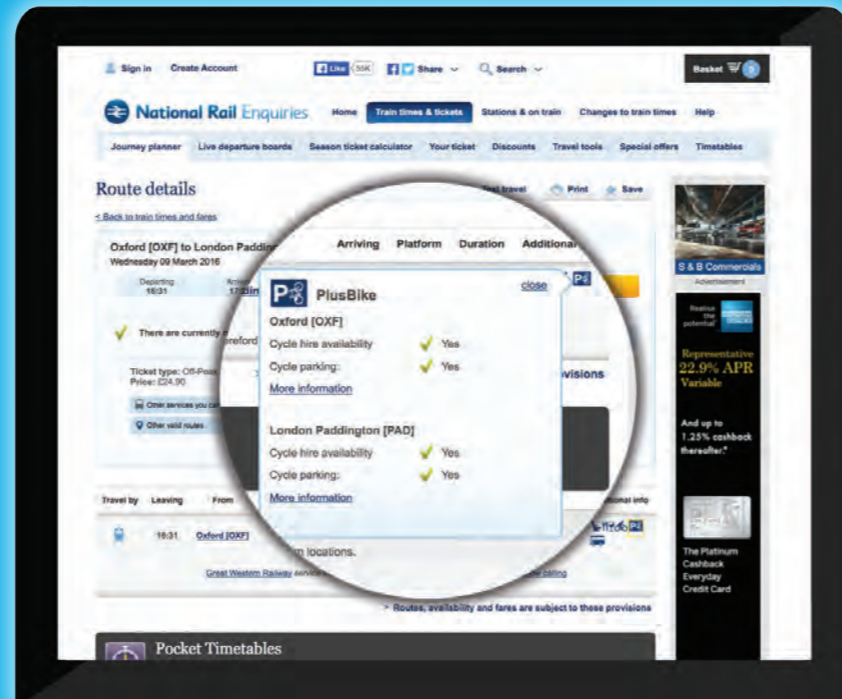
Access PlusBike for free via the National Rail website online, mobile app across Apple and Android, and tablets.

Simply use Journey Planner to plan your journey to view the information or search by station.

➤ Online:

Visit nationalrail.co.uk

1. On the home page enter your journey information under 'Train times | Buy tickets' and click 'Go'
2. Click on 'Details' for that journey
3. Scroll down to 'Additional info' on the far right and click on the PlusBike icon



➤ Mobile:

National Rail mobile app across Apple and Android, and tablets – download free.

1. Enter your information on Journey planner and select the journey
 2. Scroll down to 'Travelling with bicycle' and click
