

**Lewisham junction** video script and audio description

## Start

Audio description: The film starts with the southeastern logo before fading out to display text onscreen; Our current train routes use very busy junctions, and any delays cause a ripple effect across the network. Text ends.

Audio description: A train driver's view from inside a train cab of the tracks leading to Lewisham station from London Bridge. Ahead of the four platforms are numerous tracks crossing over each other. The driver's train is heading along a flyover before slowing to a stop at a red signal while another train cuts across the tracks from left to right to halt at one of the other platforms ahead.

Text on screen: Approaching a busy junction at Lewisham station from London Bridge. Footage supplied by Track Access.

Text on screen: After Dec 11th most of these trains will run direct to their destinations without crossing over tracks, meaning less delays, halts and disruption.

Audio description: The signal light changes from red to green and the driver's train proceeds into Lewisham station onto a different platform on the left of screen, crossing over the multiple tracks. The film fades and changes to a time lapse video of the same tracks but from the opposite view from a platform on Lewisham station.

A train is seen going past towards the busy junction whilst another waits for it to pass before it moves forward. This happens multiple times as trains arrive on different tracks and have to wait before they can cross. A green arrow appears showing that trains south of the junction will run direct to Charing Cross. A blue arrow appears showing that trains north of the junction will run direct to Cannon Street. Towards the end a freight train can be seen departing Lewisham station and heading towards London Bridge station whilst another passenger train waits for the tracks to clear.

Audio description: The screen fades out to display Southeastern logo.

Ends
